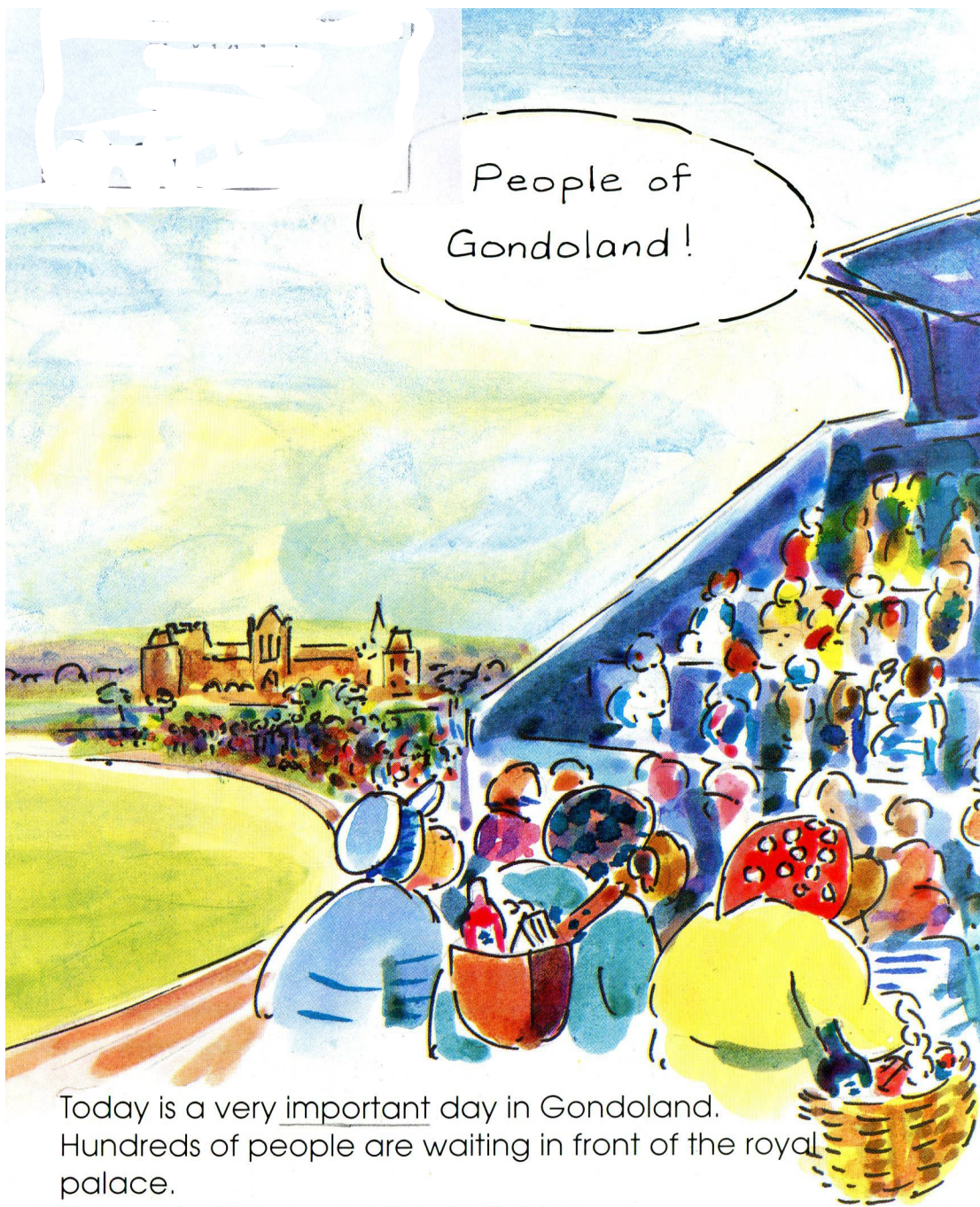

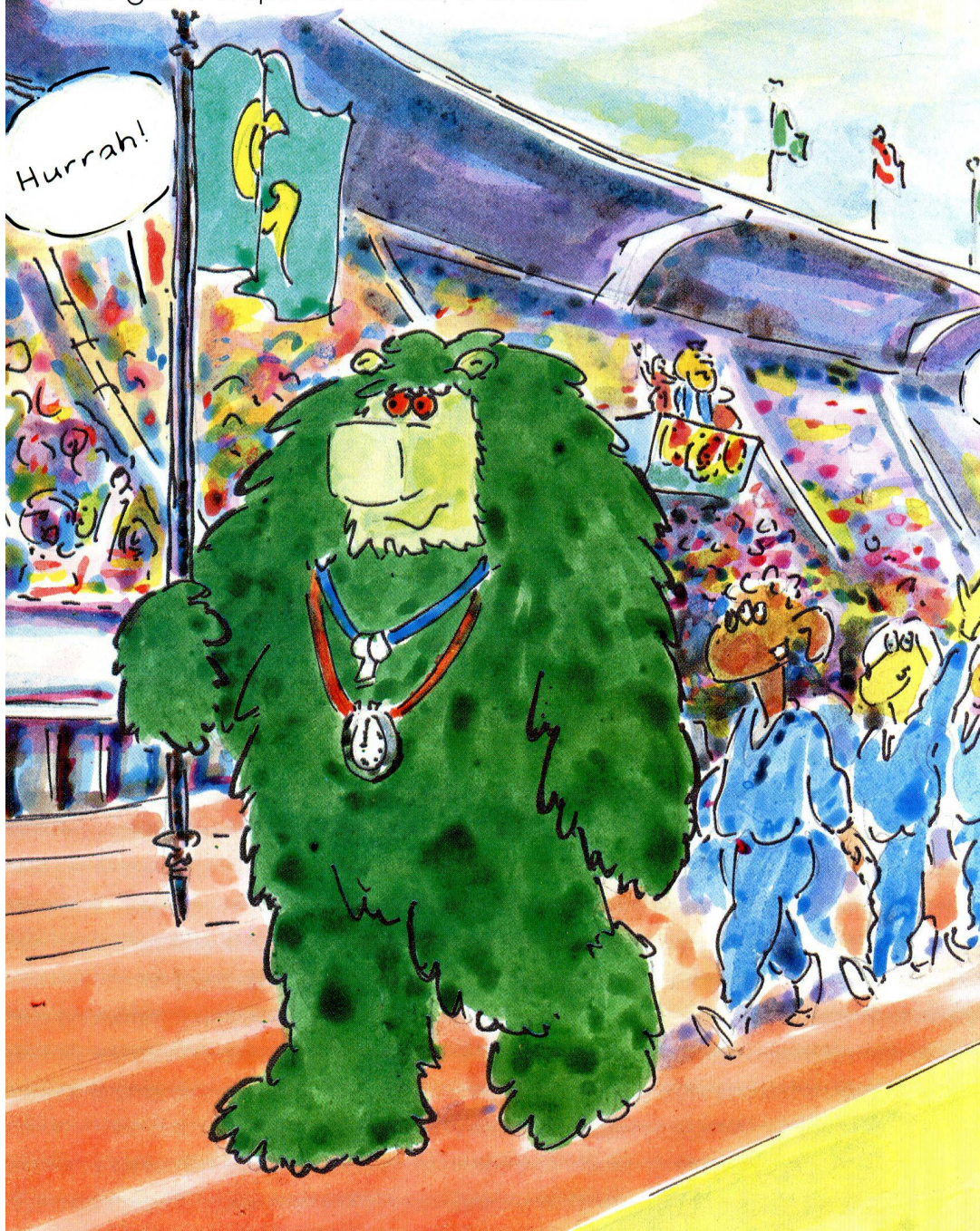


Today is a very important day in Gondoland.

Everyone has got lots of sandwiches and lemonade.

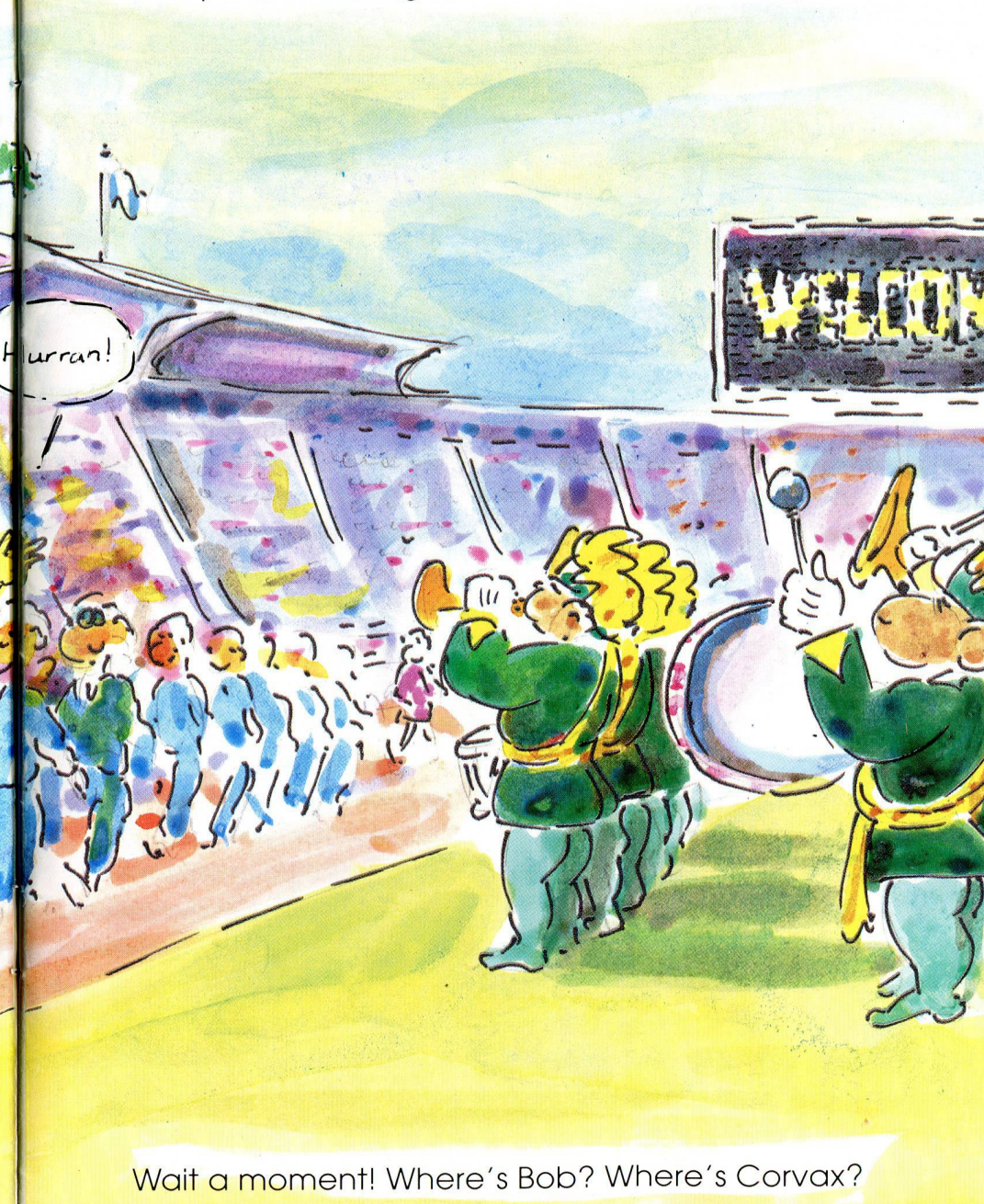


It's nine o'clock. Here come the King, the Queen

 He's number 13.



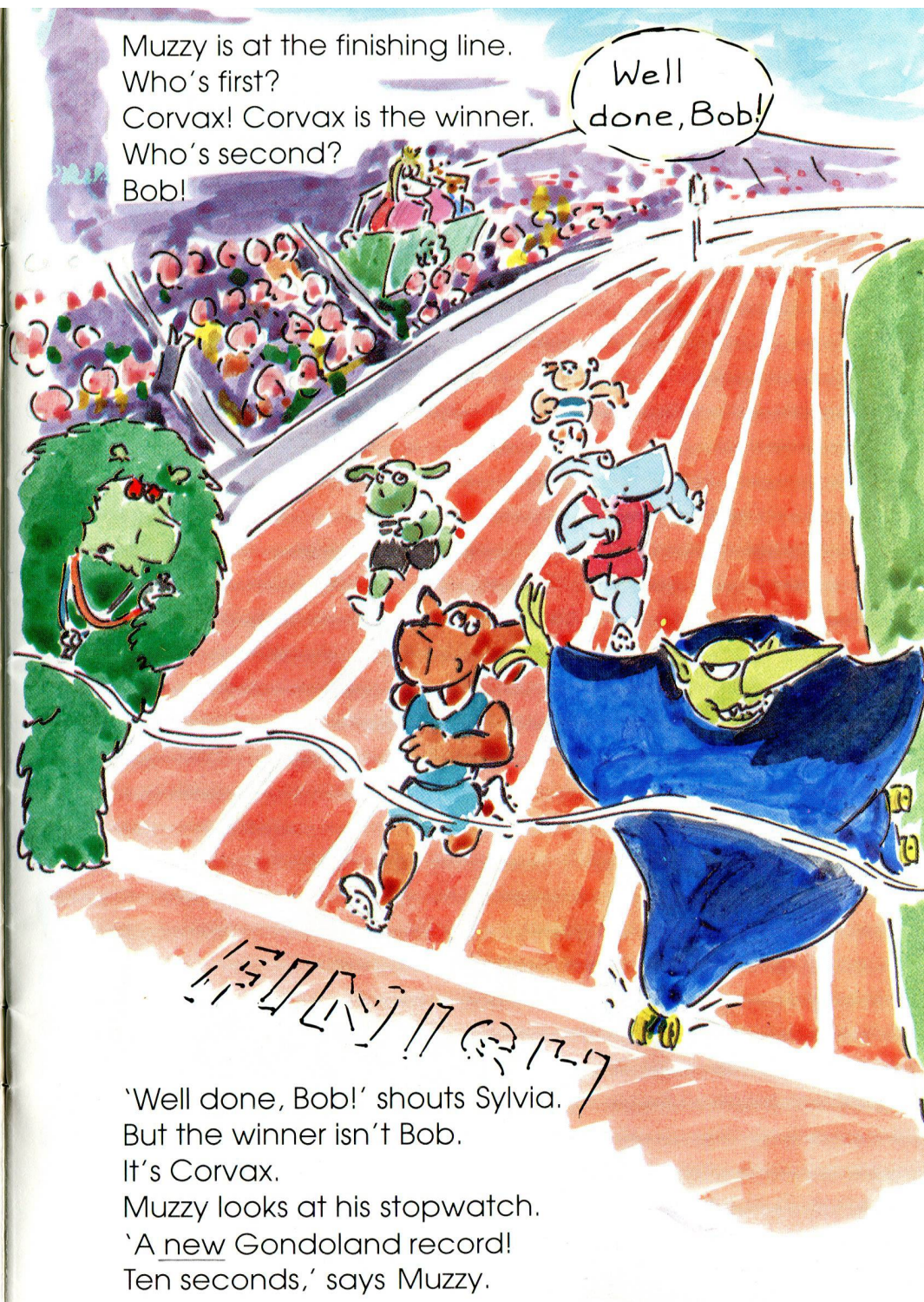
Where's Muzzy?

Bob!

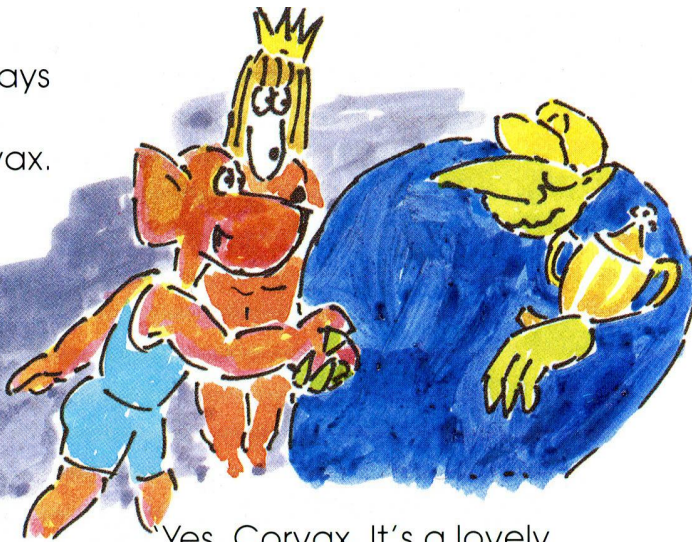
Well done, Bob!

Ready? GO!

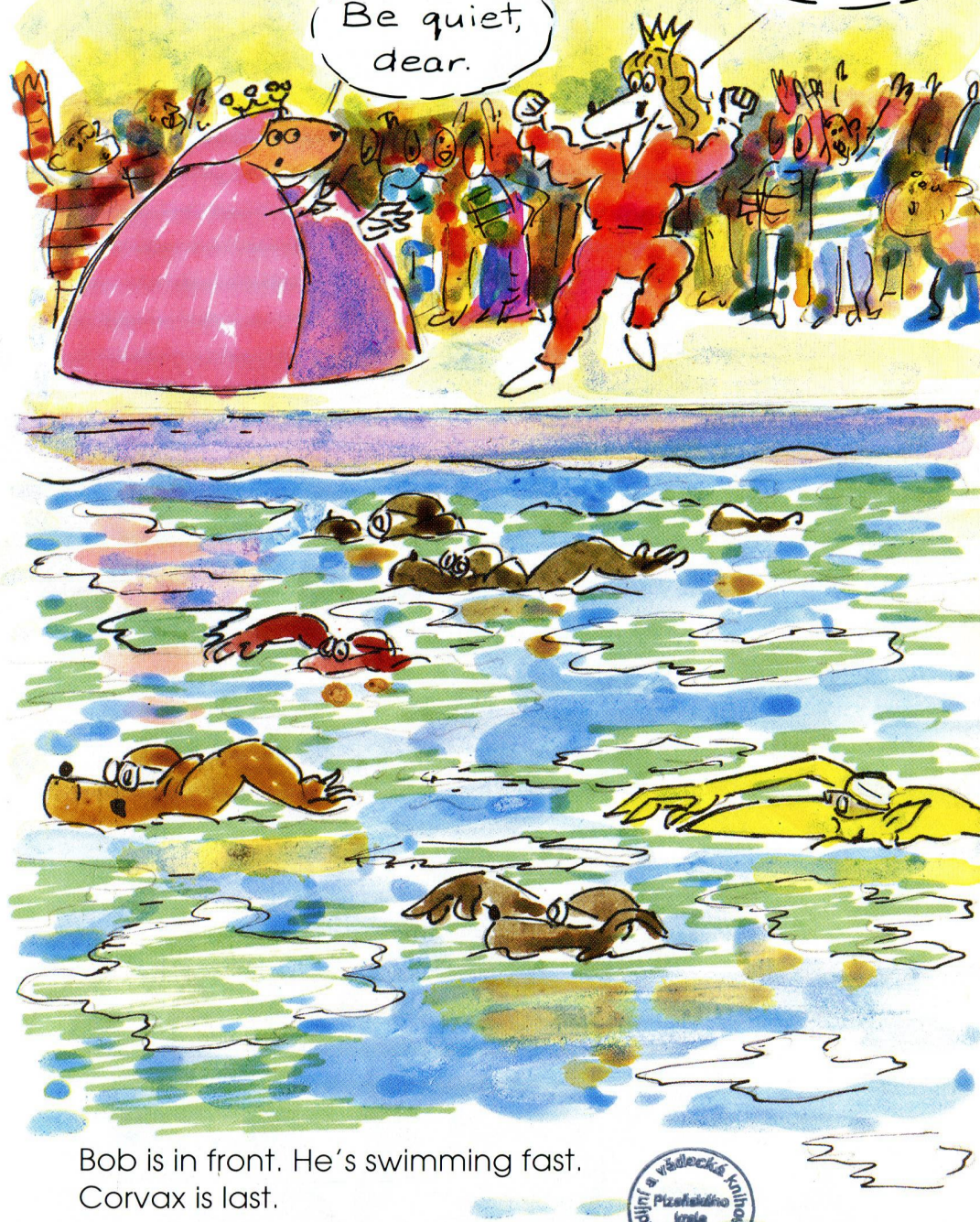
Muzzy blows his whistle. The swimmers jump into the water. There's a great splash. Everyone is wet.

dear.



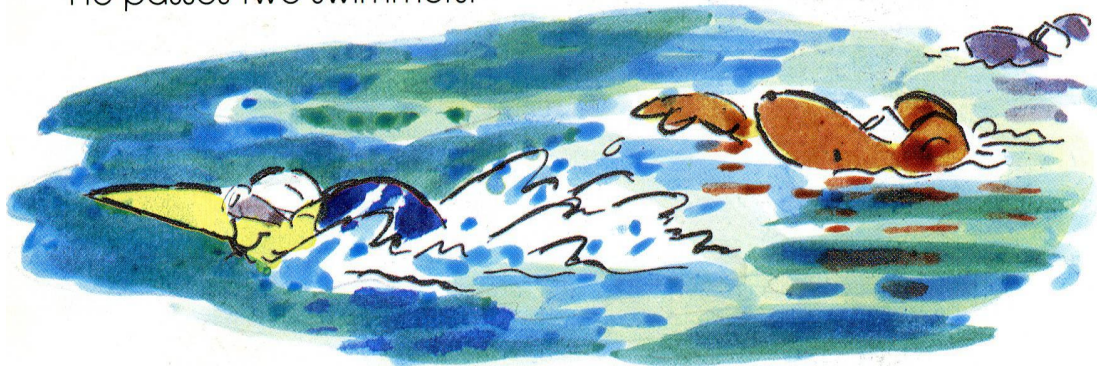
Bob is in front. He's swimming fast.
Corvax is last.



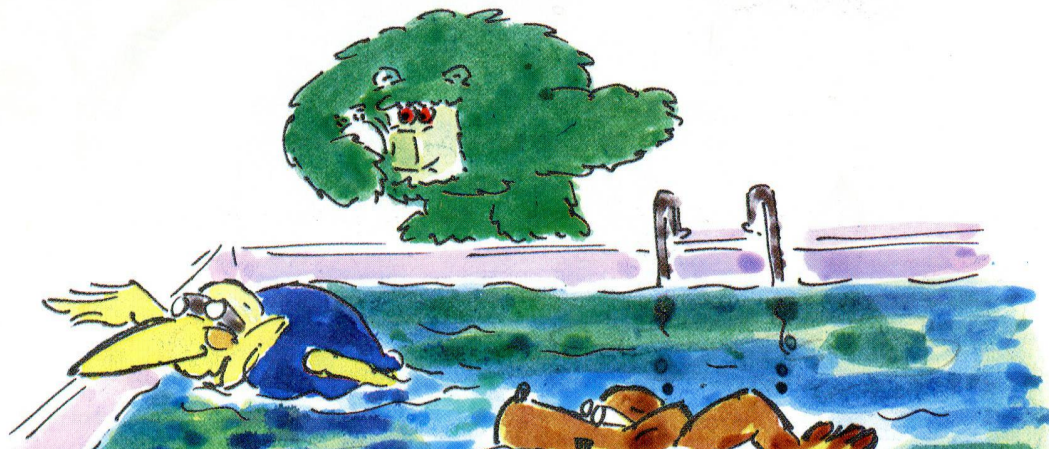
Look! Corvax isn't last. He's going faster.

He passes two swimmers.



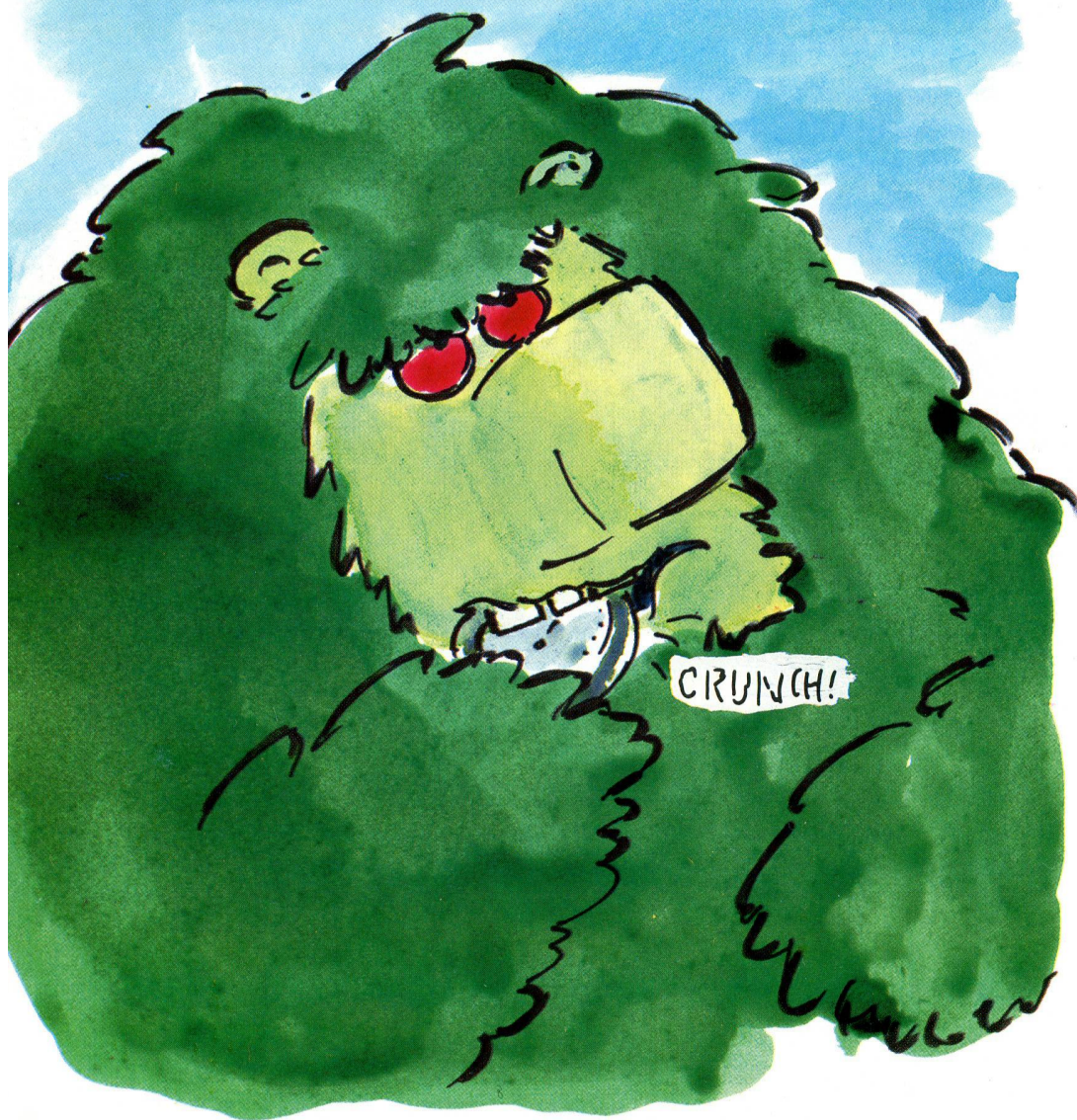
He passes Bob! He wins the race!

She's right. Corvax is cheating.

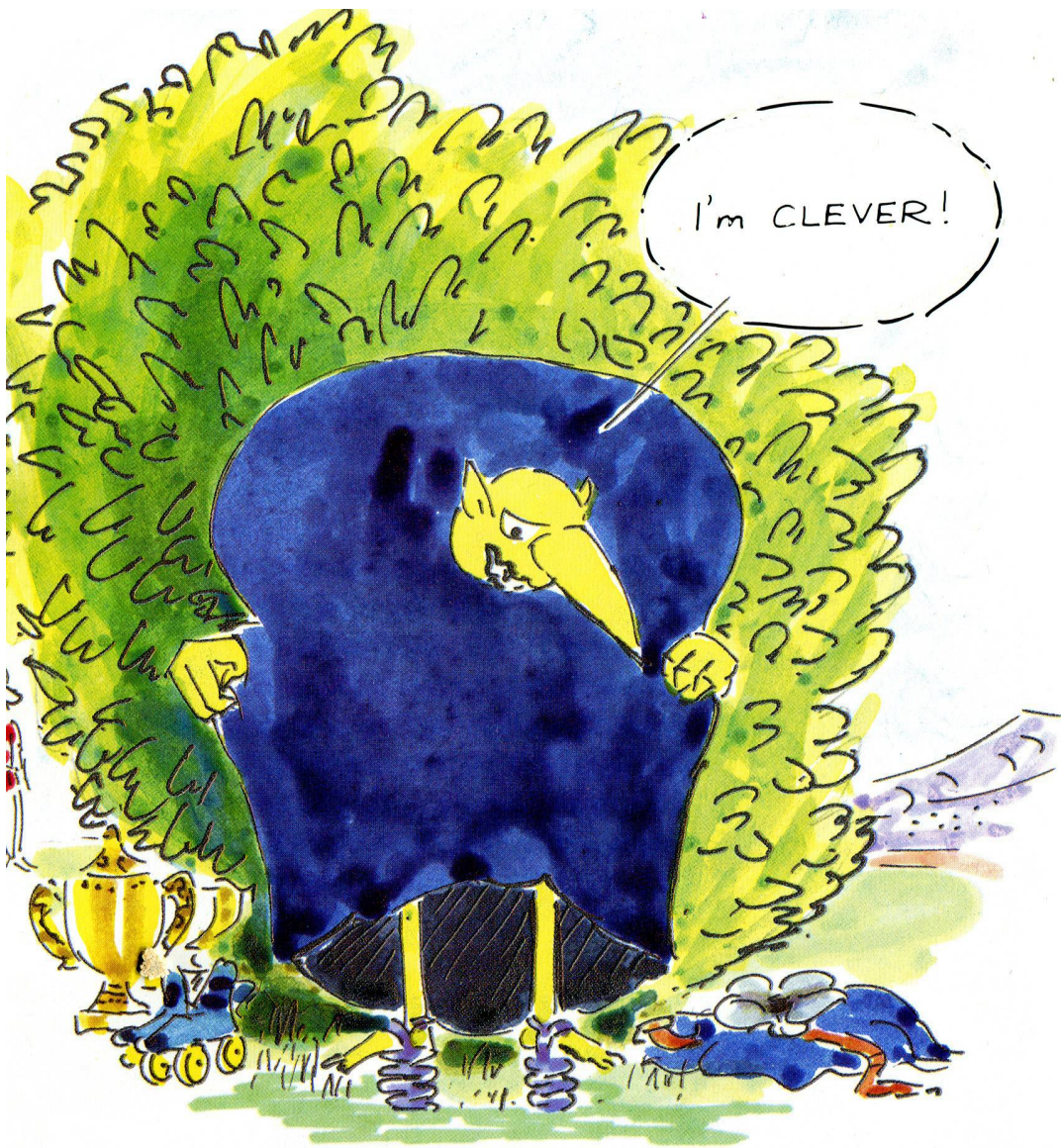


Muzzy is thinking the same as Sylvia. He looks at his stopwatch again. Then he eats it.

'Oh, dear! The roller-skating competition is at half past eleven. Where are my roller-skates?'

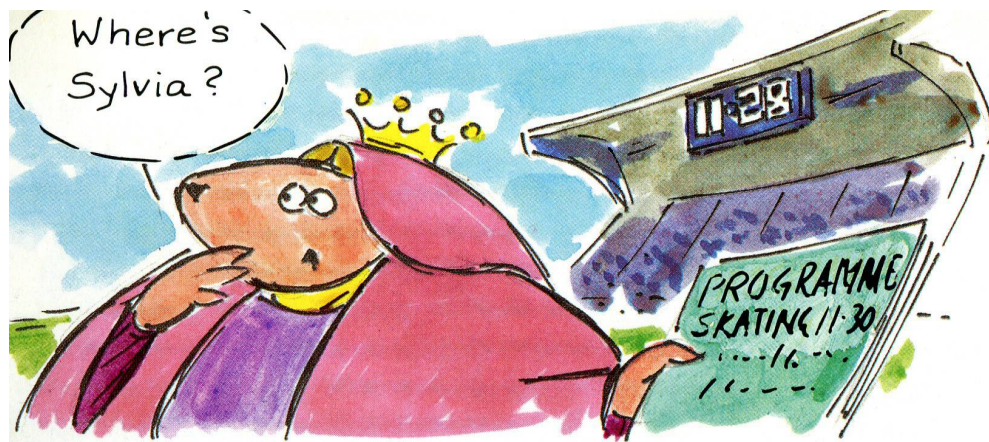


Corvax is getting ready for his next event.

What's this?

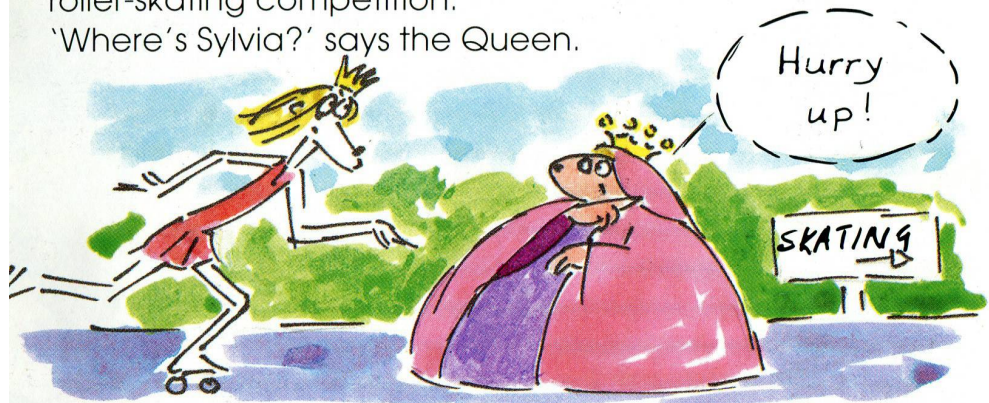


Aha! I see....Corvax isn't the winner.

'Be quiet, dear,' says the King.



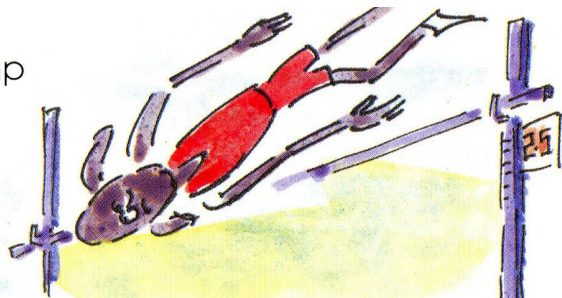
There are ten roller-skaters. They are all very good at roller-skating - but the winner is Princess Sylvia.

 Muzzy eats another stopwatch - delicious!



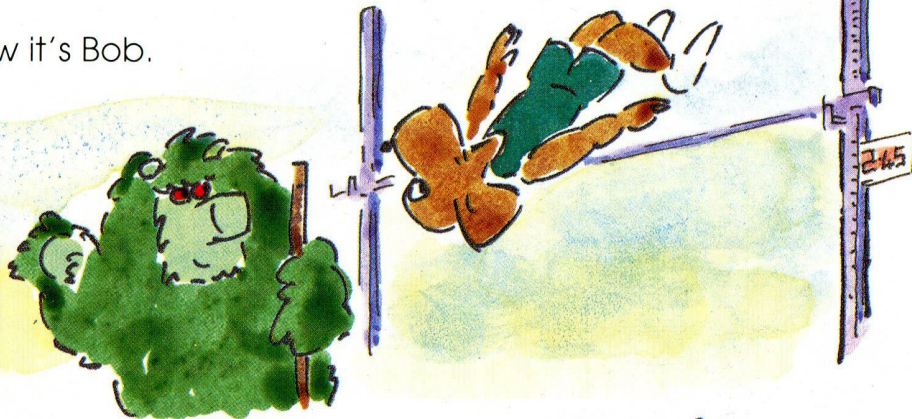
The Gondoland high jump champion is doing his exercises.

Now it's Bob.

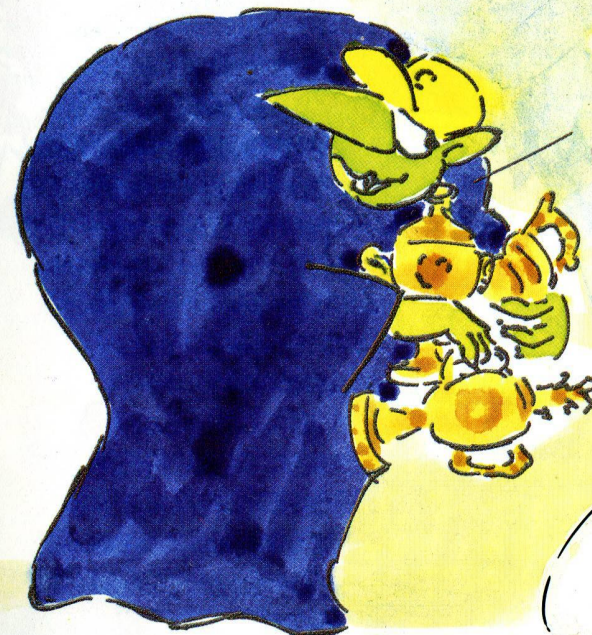


Two metres 45. That's very good, Bob.
Now it's Corvax.



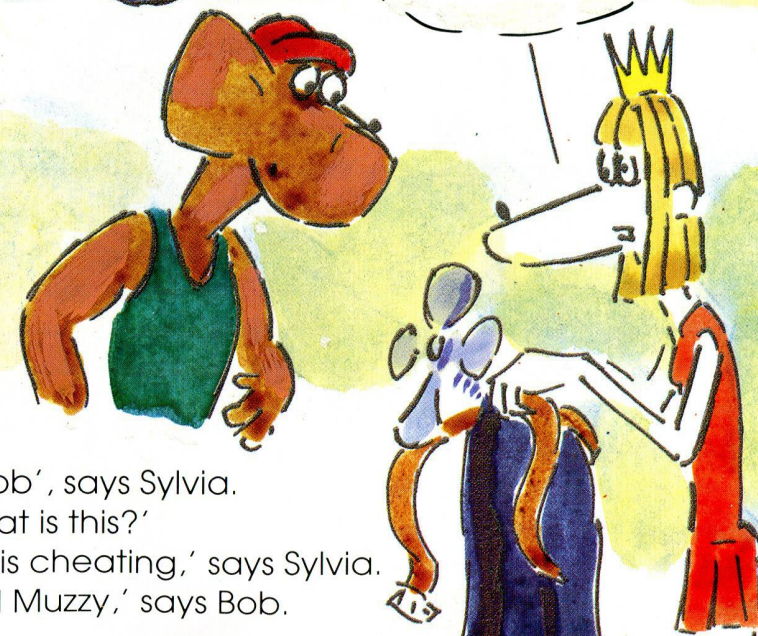
Five metres!

Now he's got three prizes.



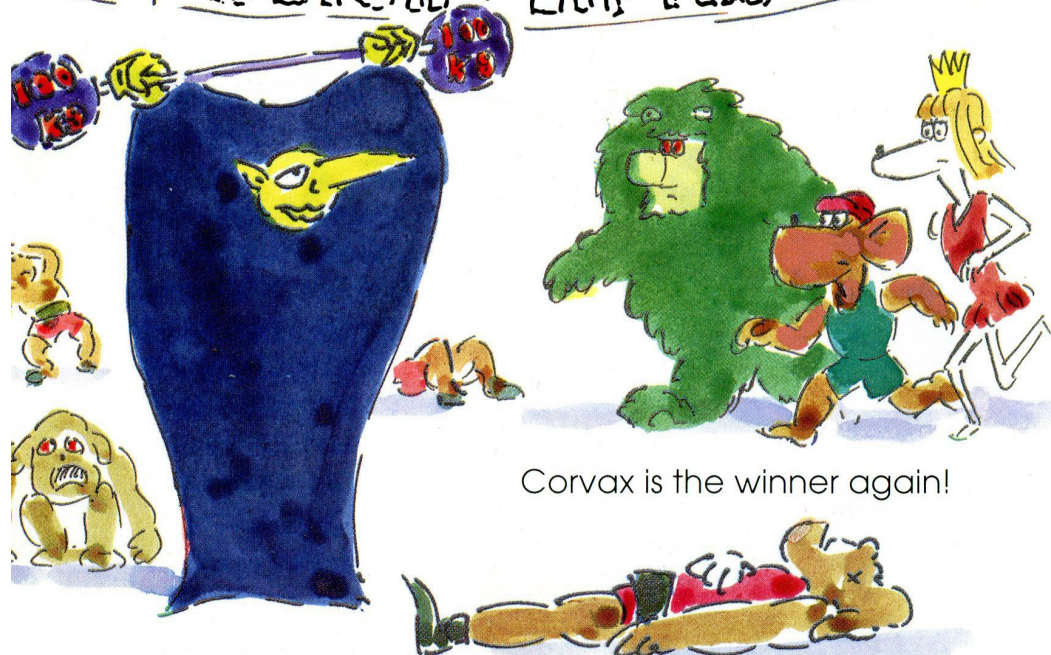
Look Sylvia!

'Let's tell Muzzy,' says Bob.

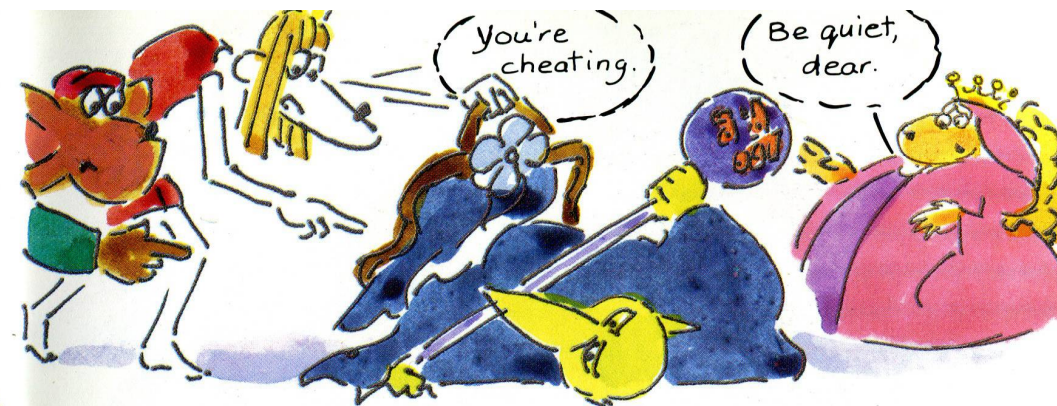
WEIGHT LIFTING
