

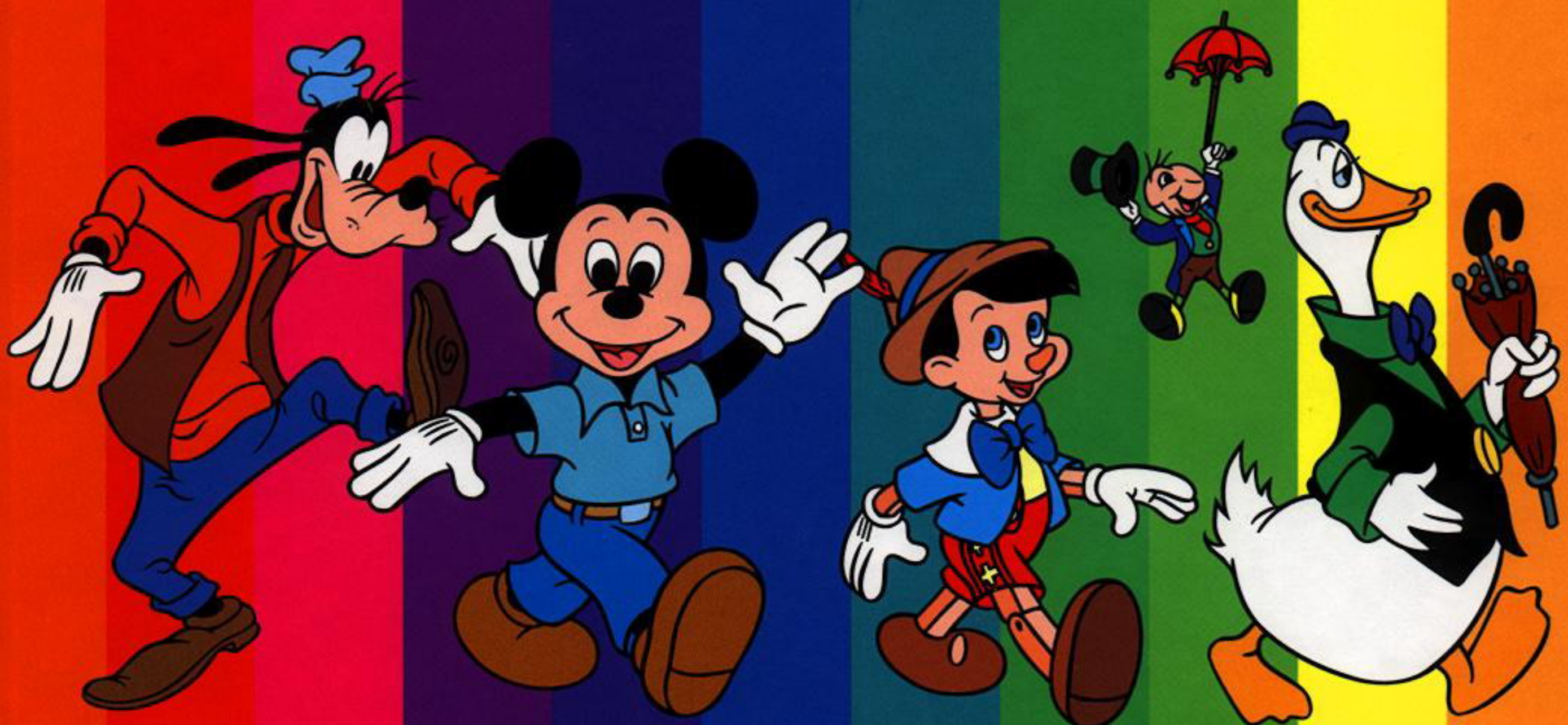

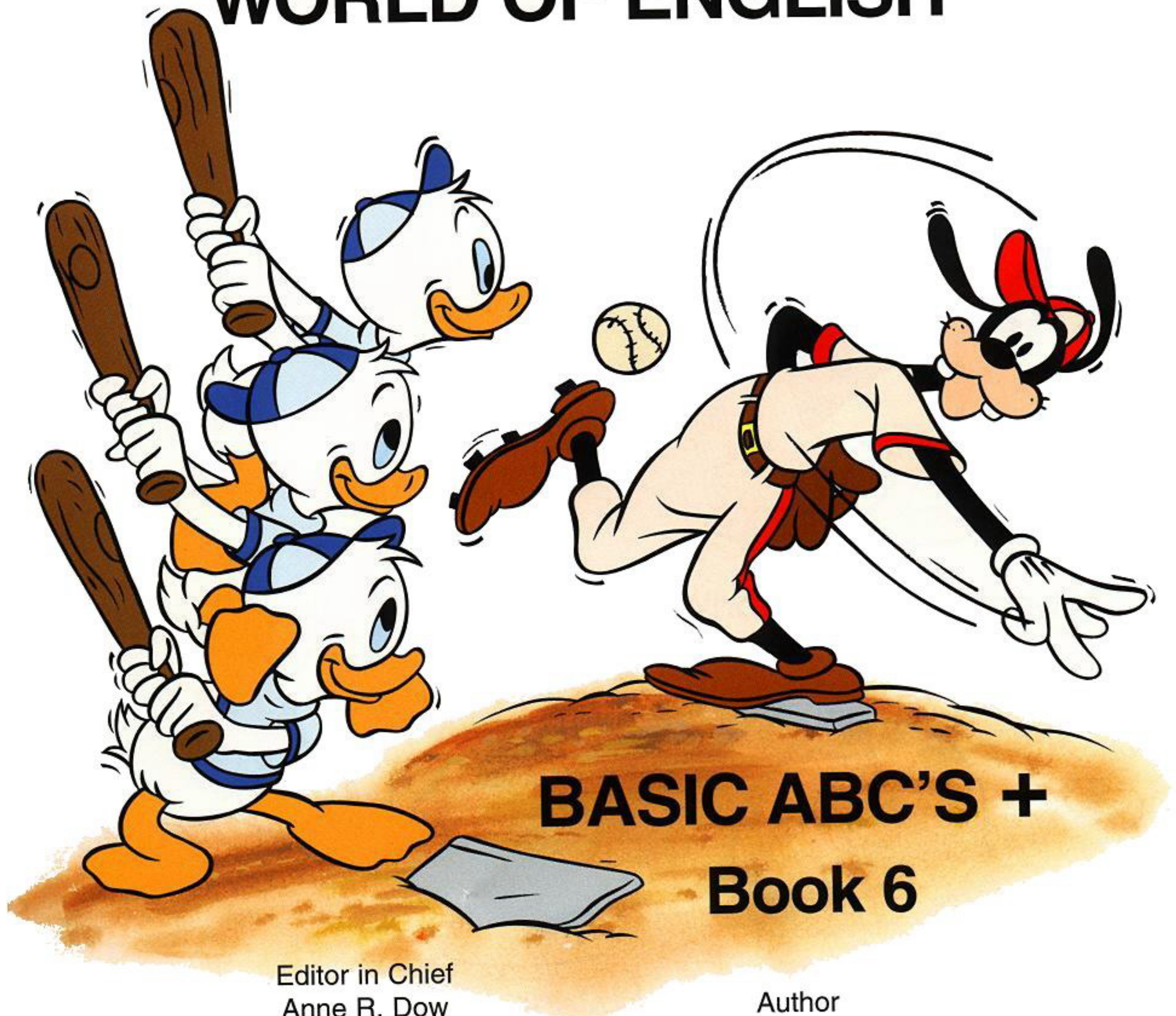

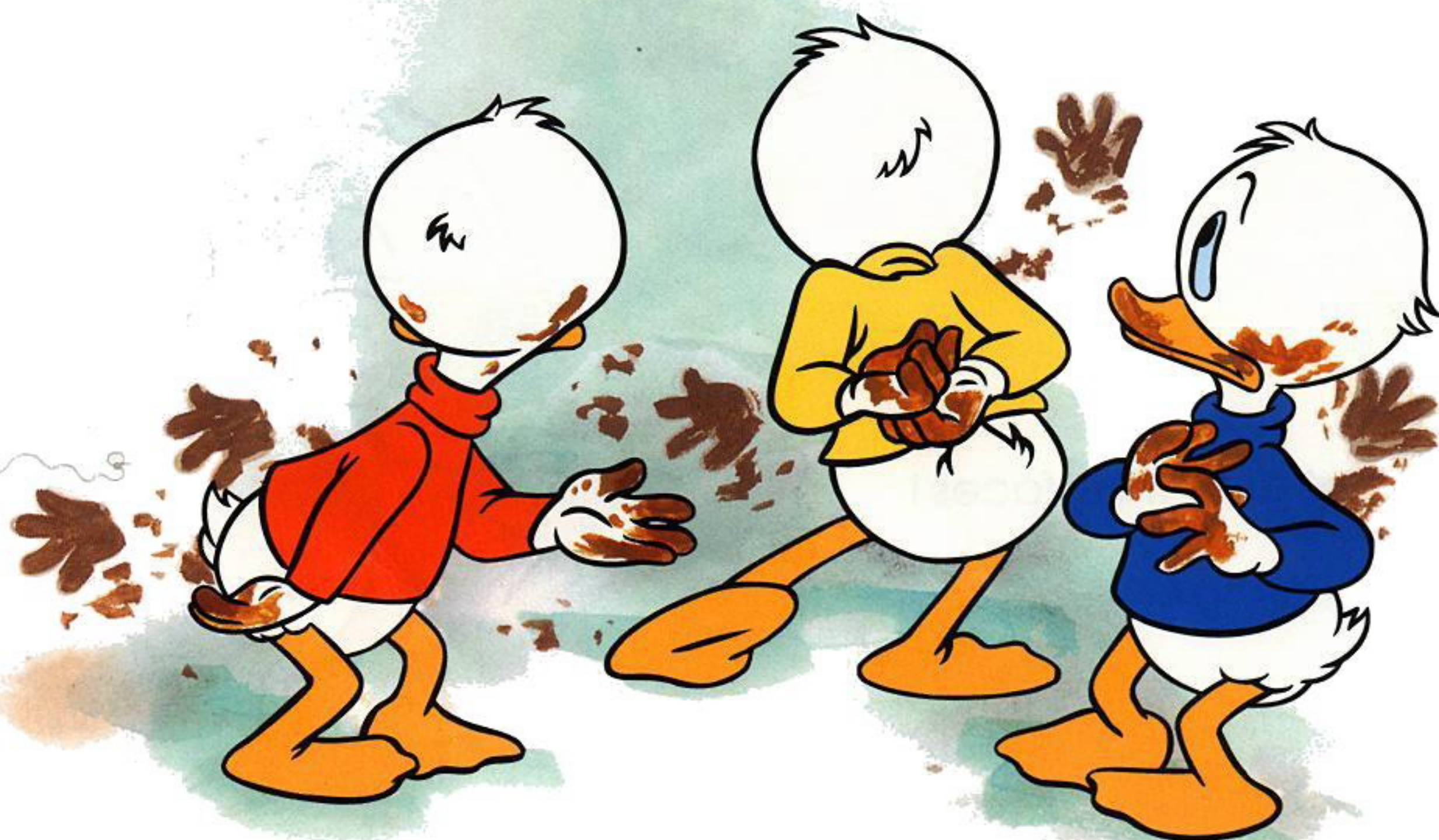


Here come Grandma Duck and Daisy.

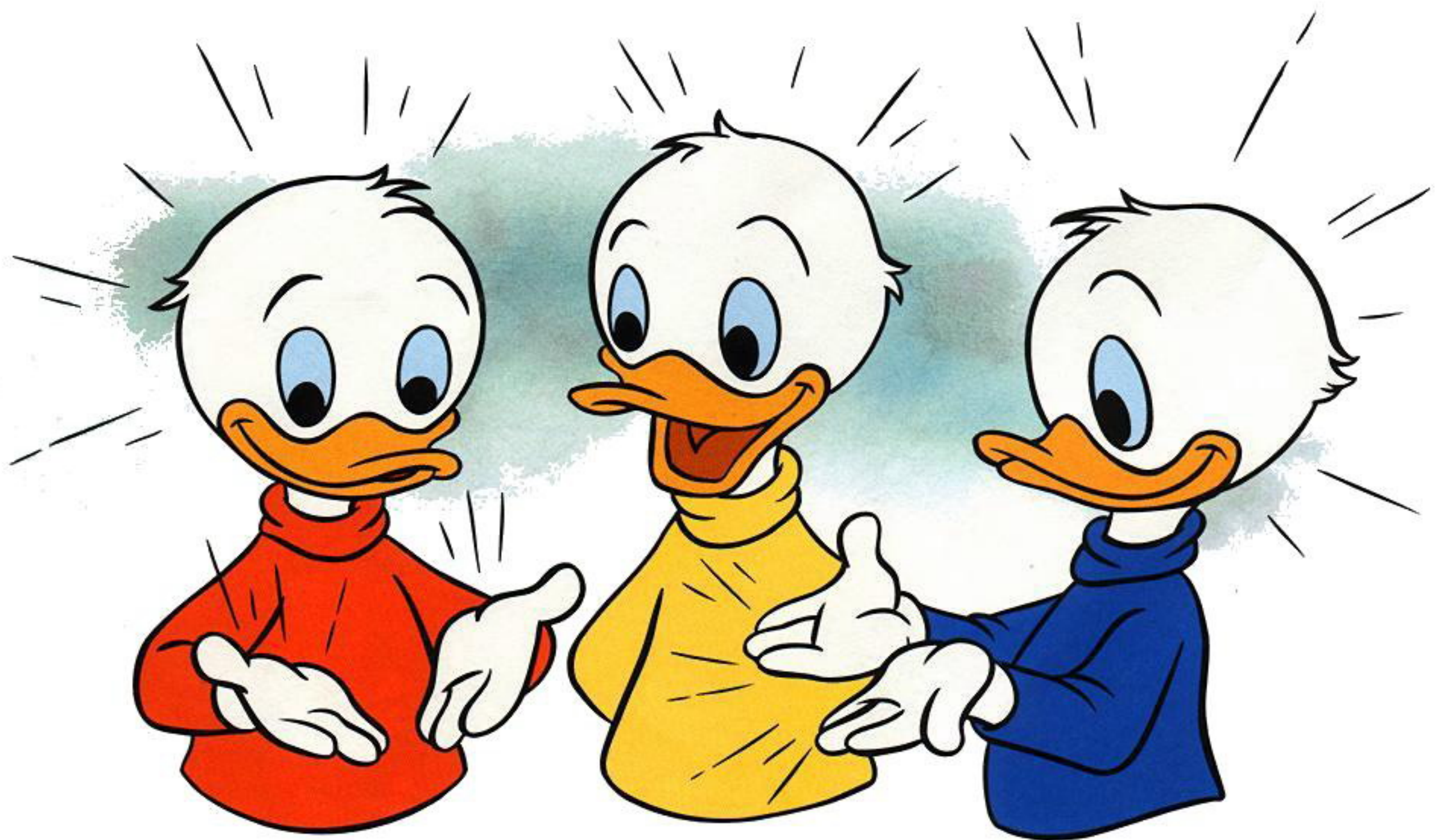


Huey is washing

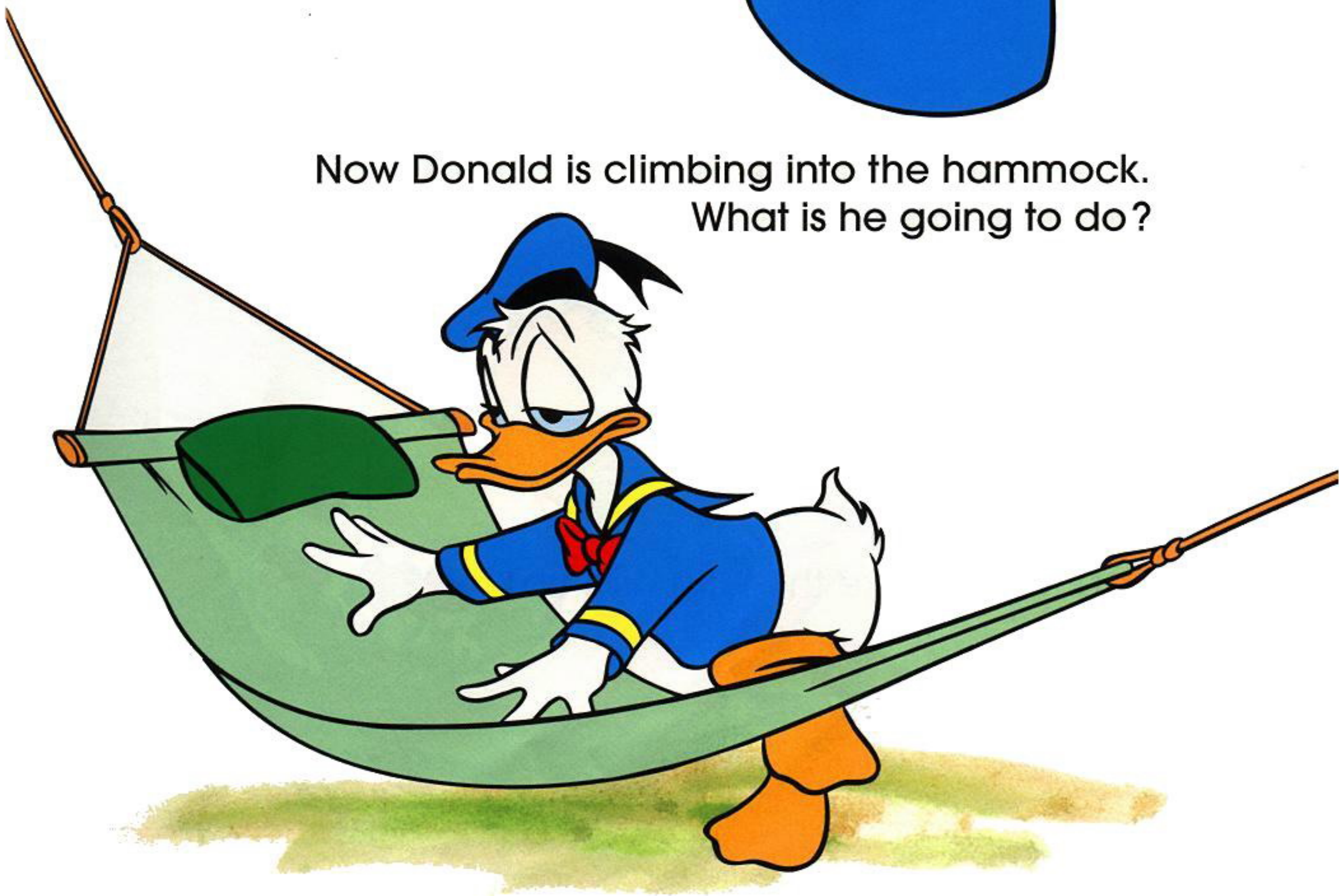
Donald is very sleepy.



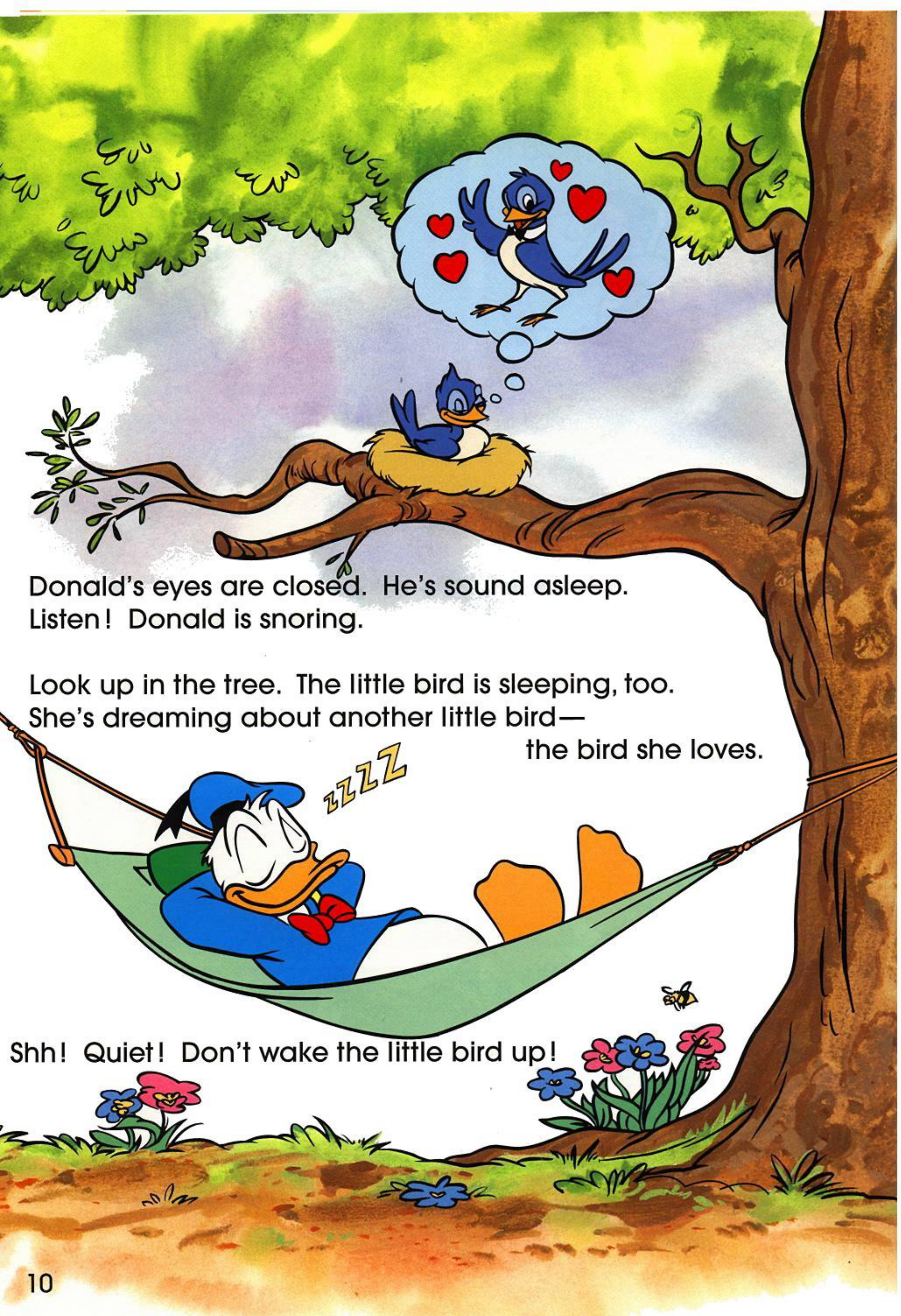
Look! He's yawning.

What is he going to do?







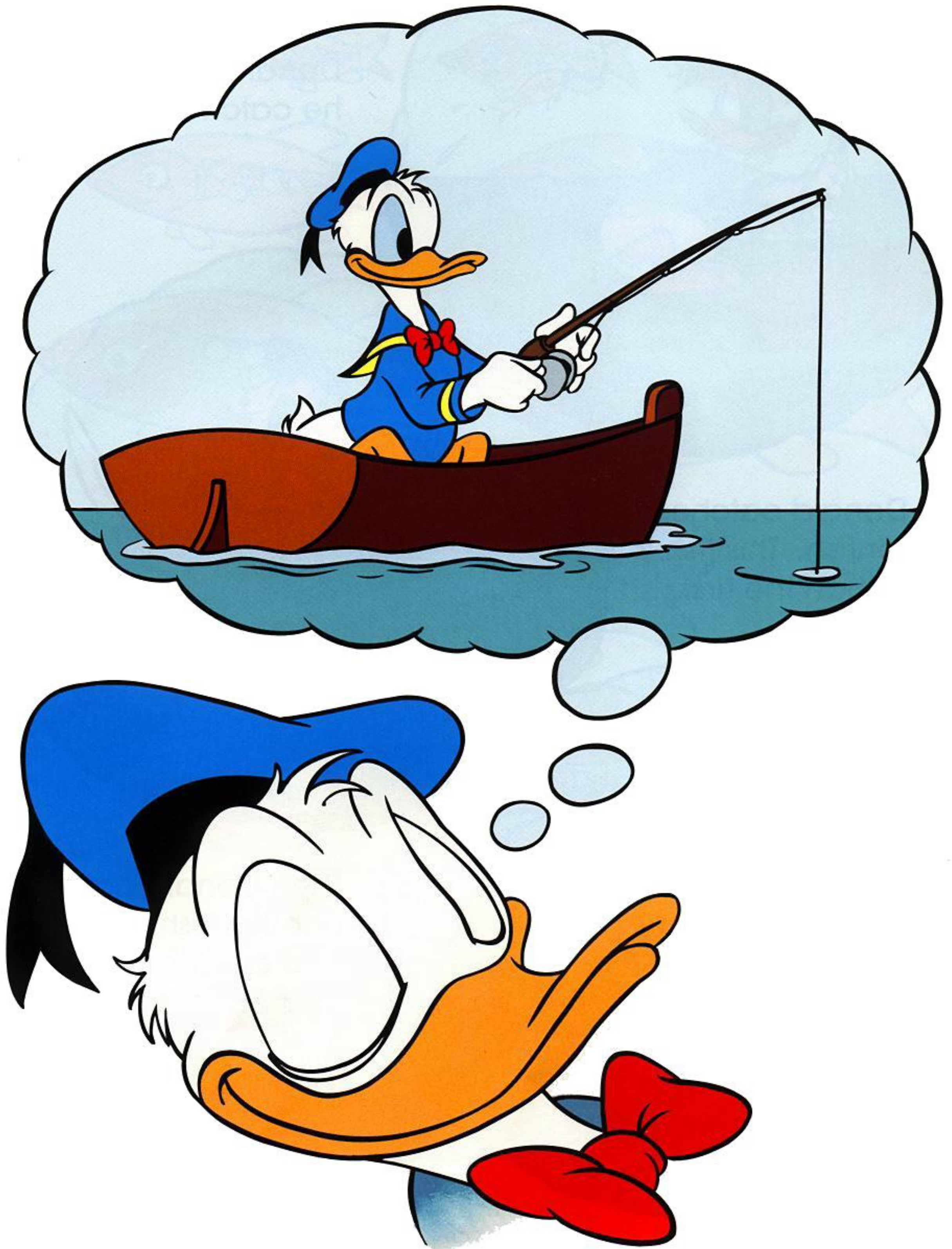
Donald's eyes are closed. He's sound asleep.

He's dreaming that he's fishing.

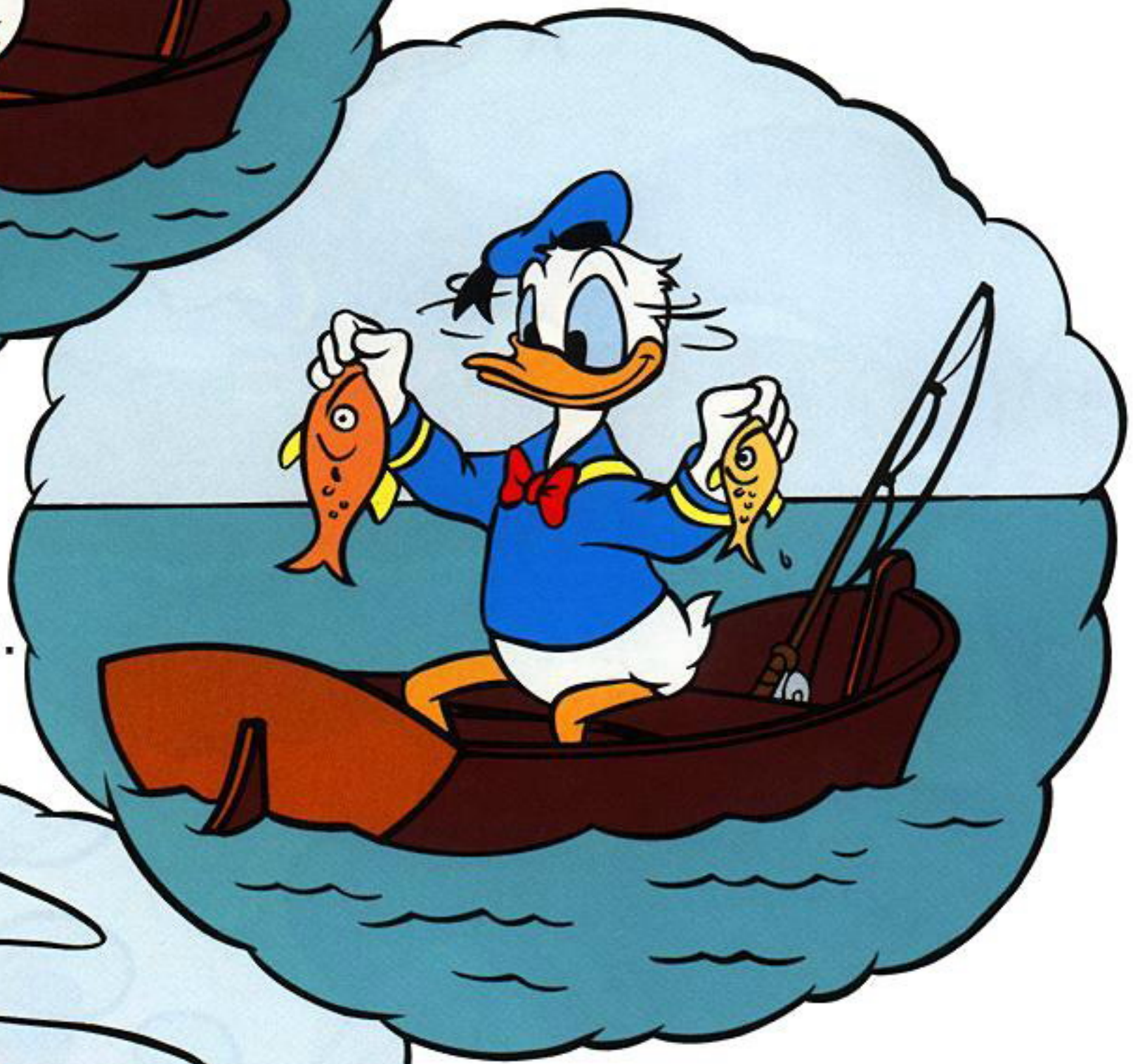




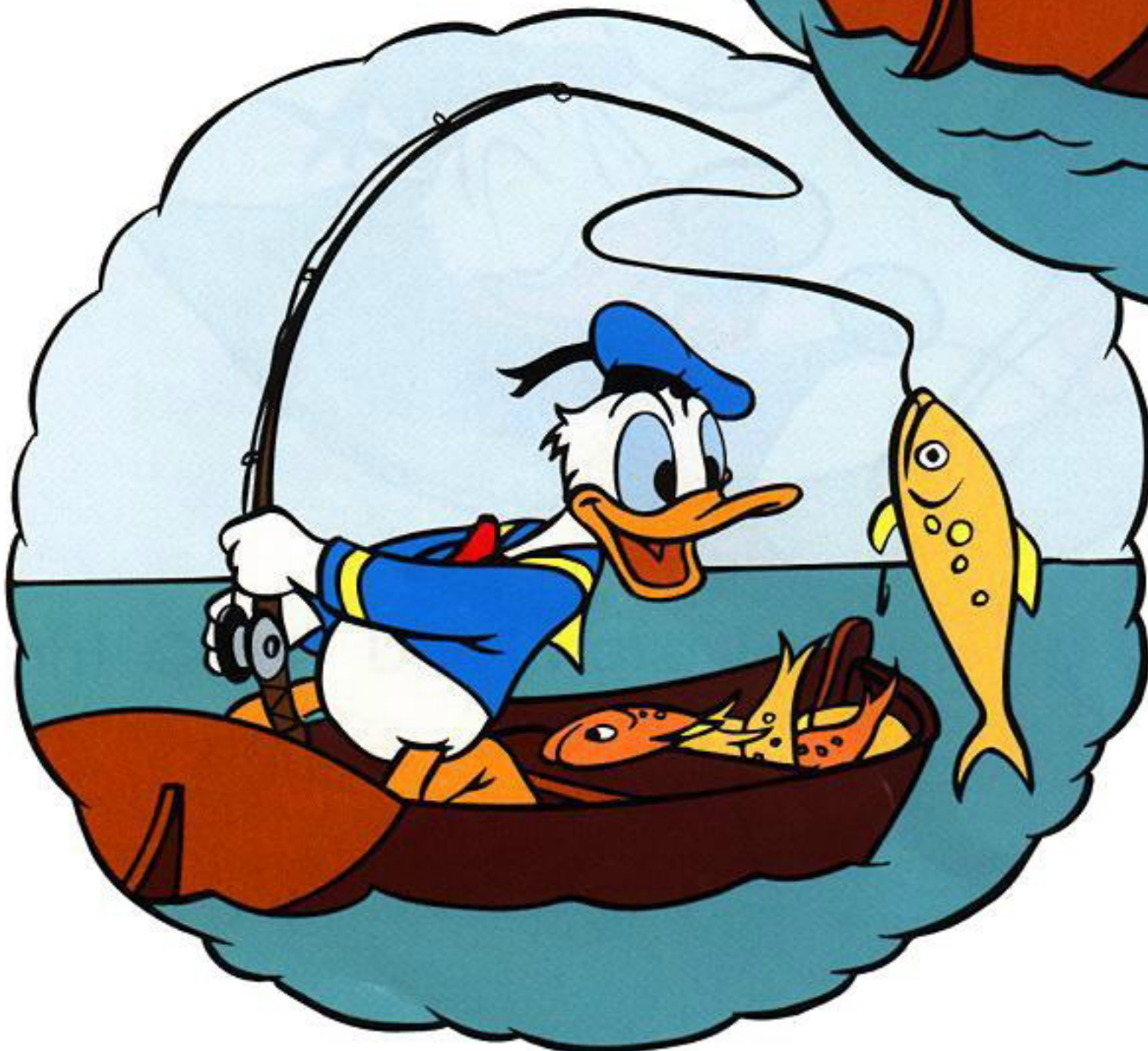


Donald dreams that he catches a fish.

Then Donald catches another fish. This fish is bigger than the first fish.

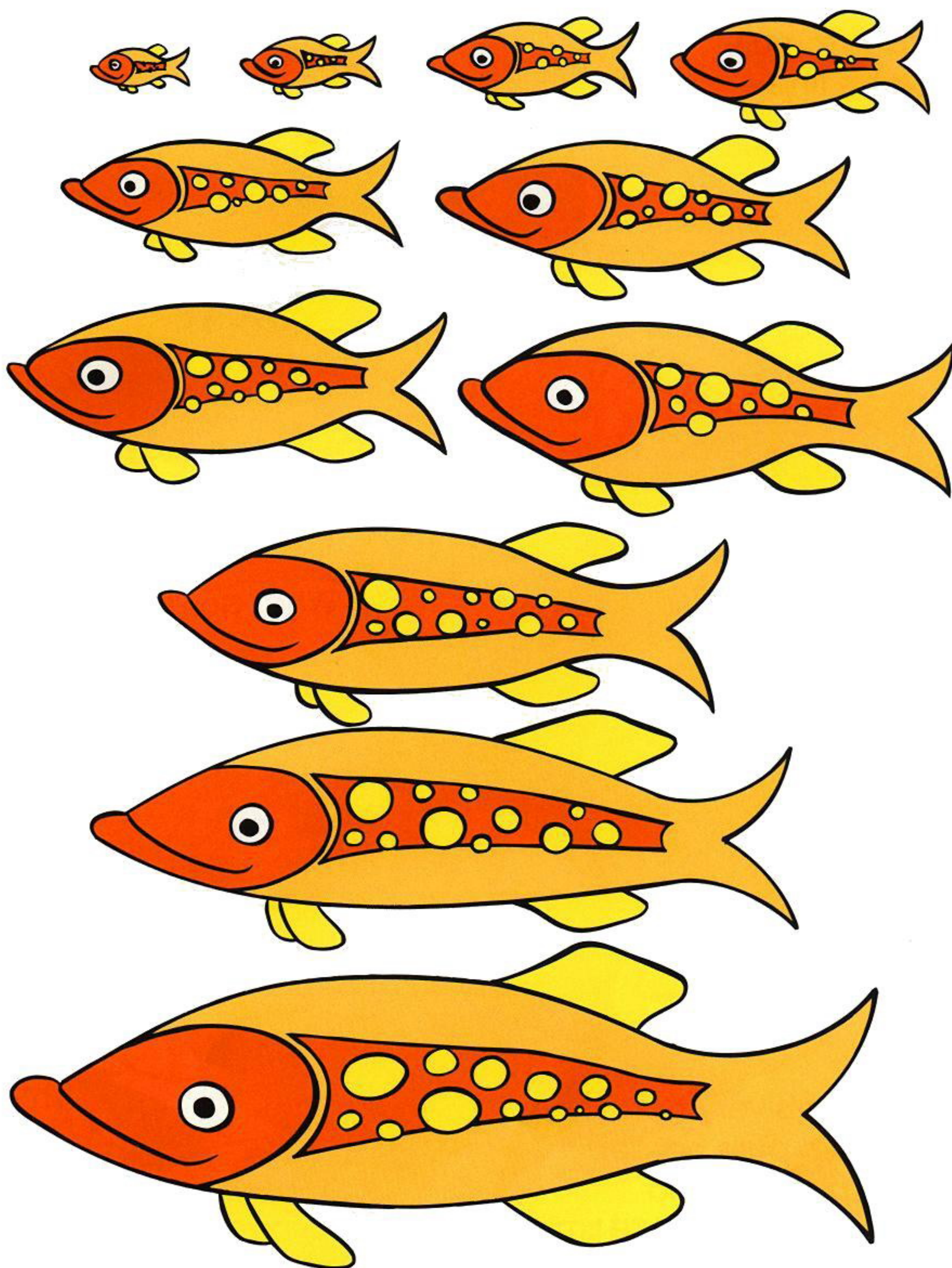


Then Donald catches another fish and another and another. And each fish is bigger than the one before.



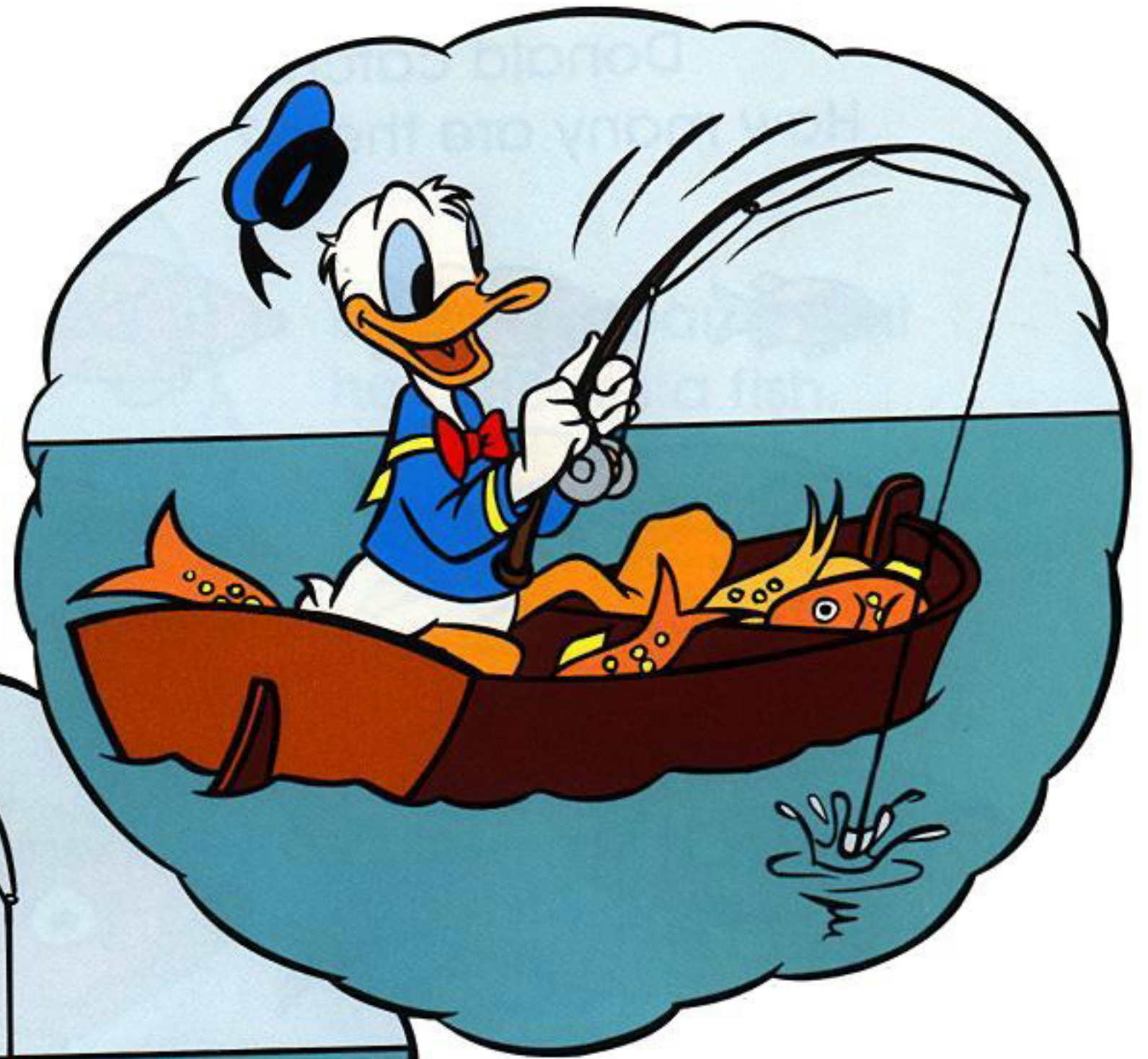


Donald catches all of these fish.  
How many are there? Count them and see.

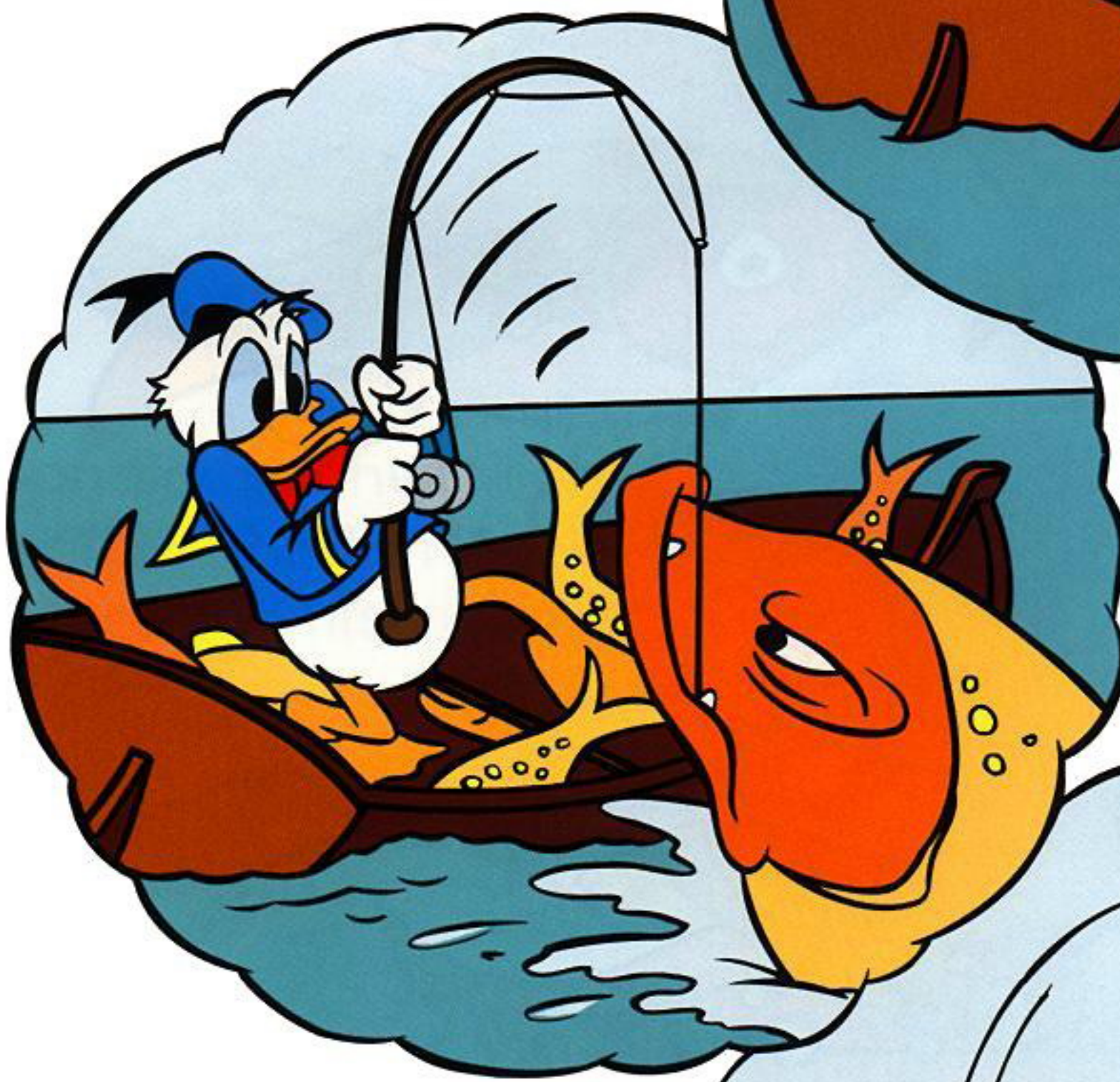




Donald puts his line

Wake up, Donald! It's only a bad dream.



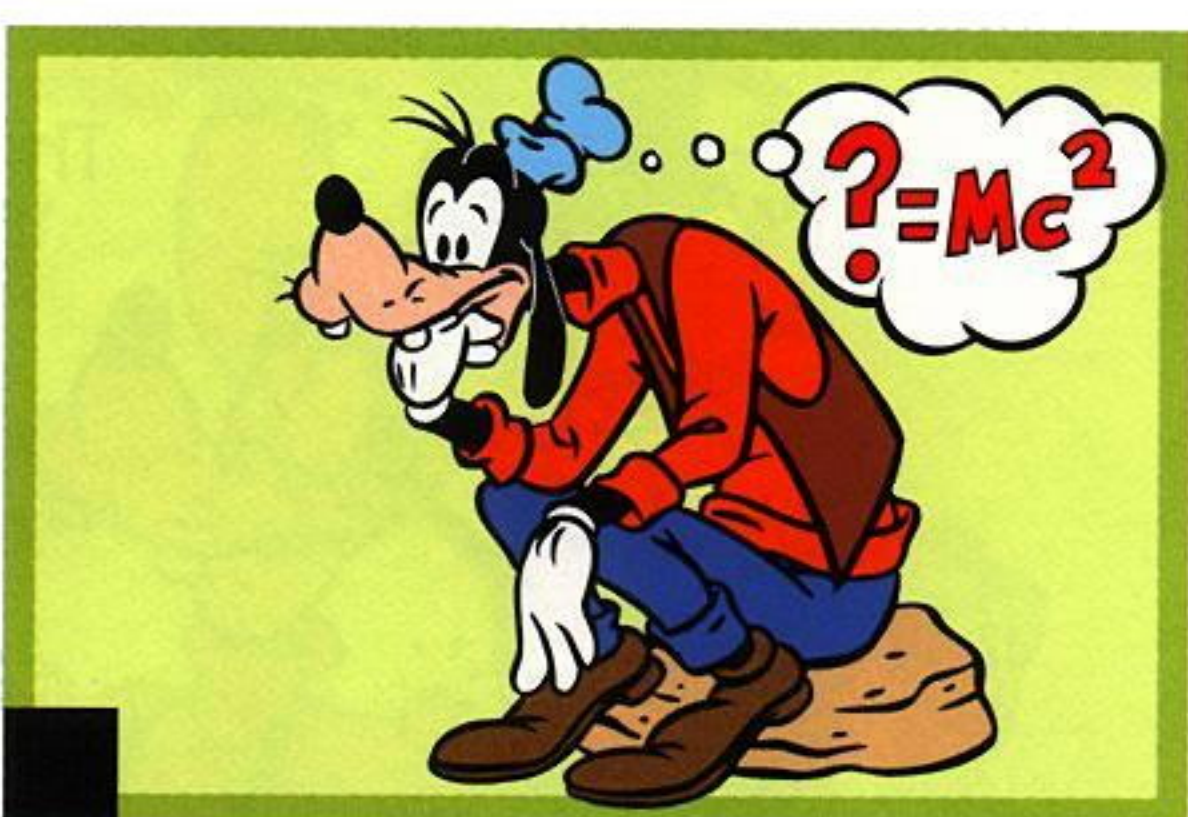

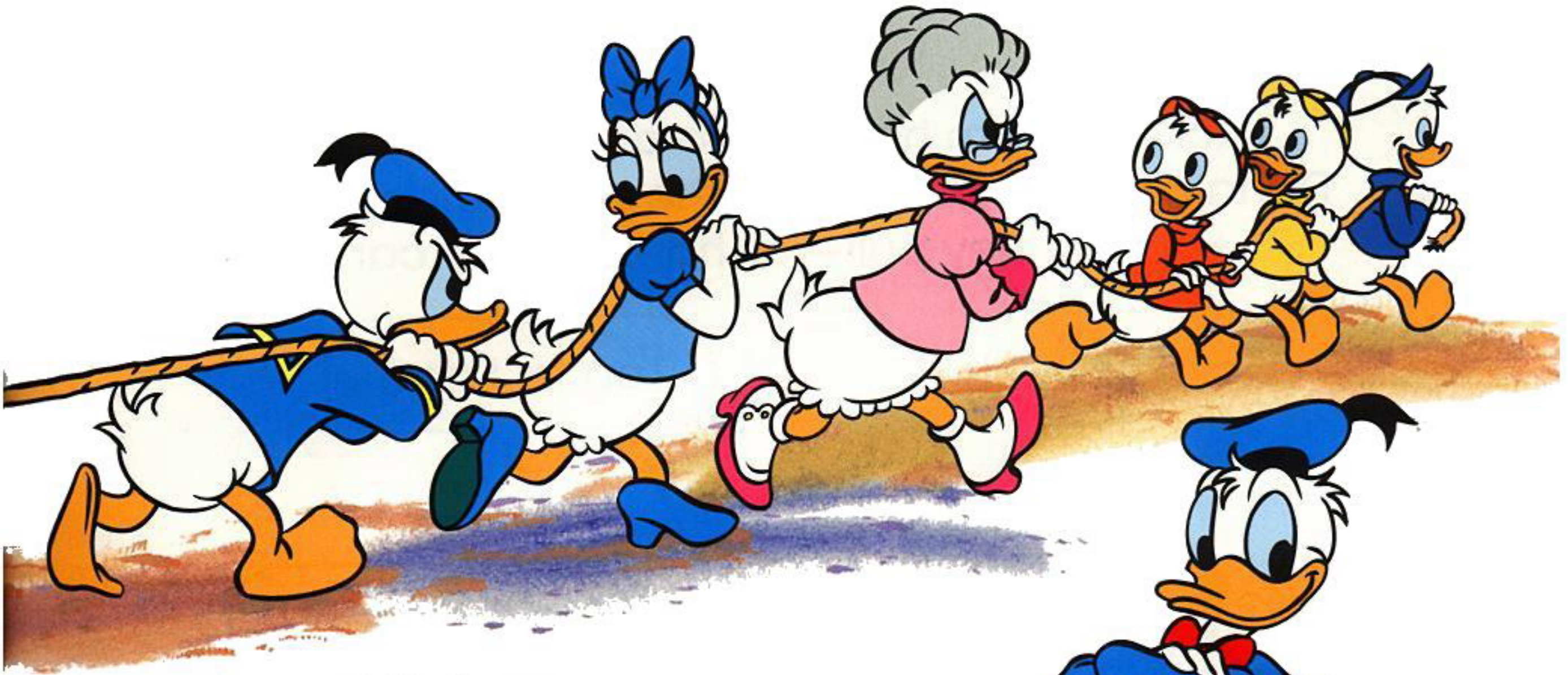


This is Mickey's team. Look at Goofy!  
He thinks he's very strong!

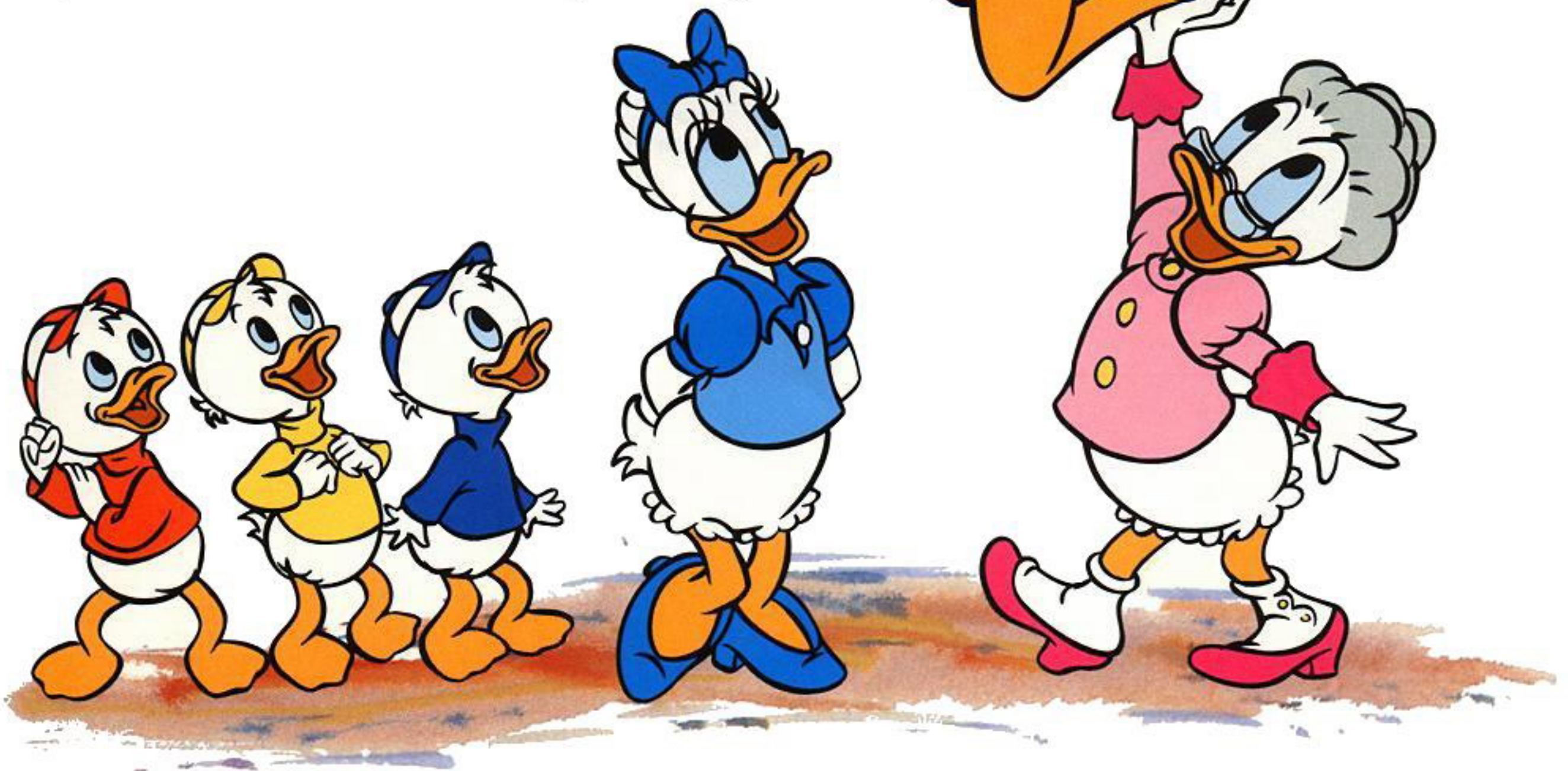




They're going to have a contest.  
They're going to see which team is stronger.

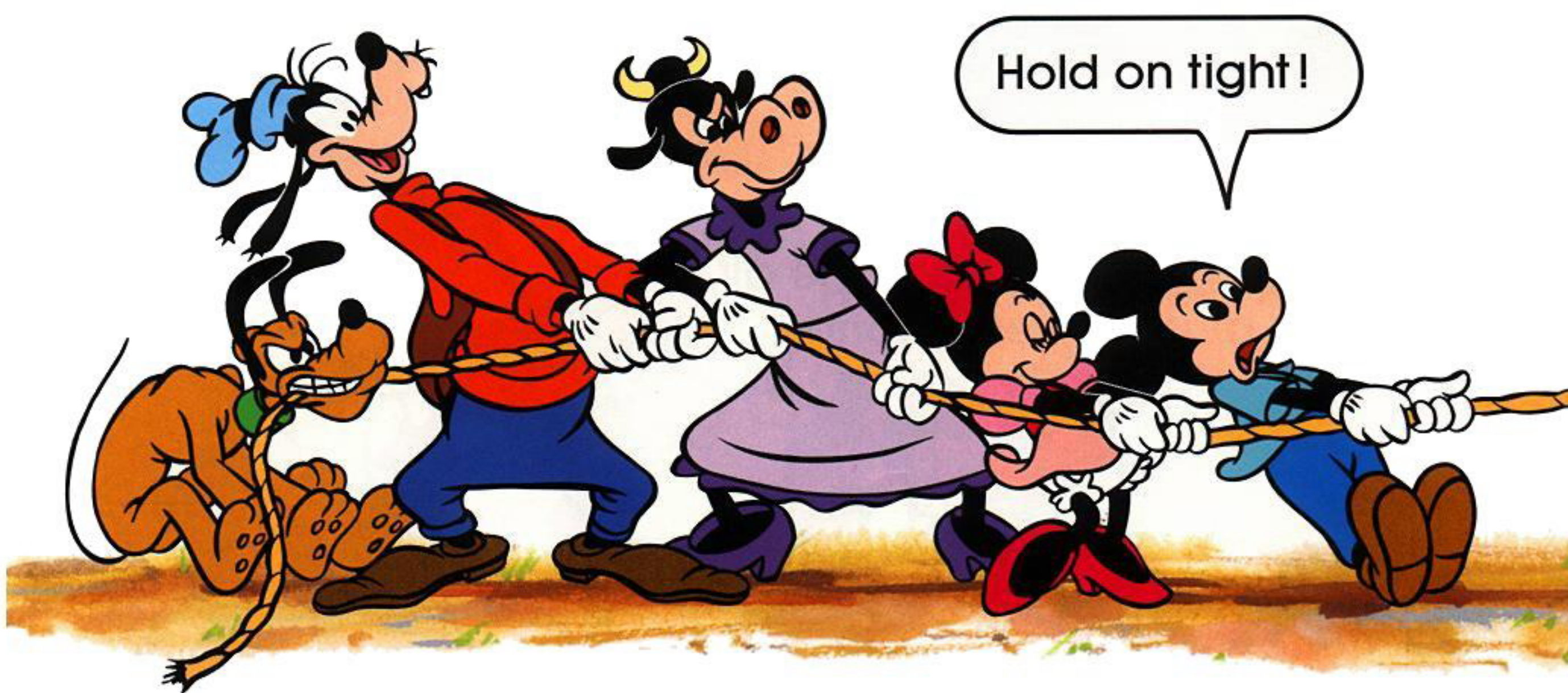


This is Donald's team.

Grandma must be very strong.

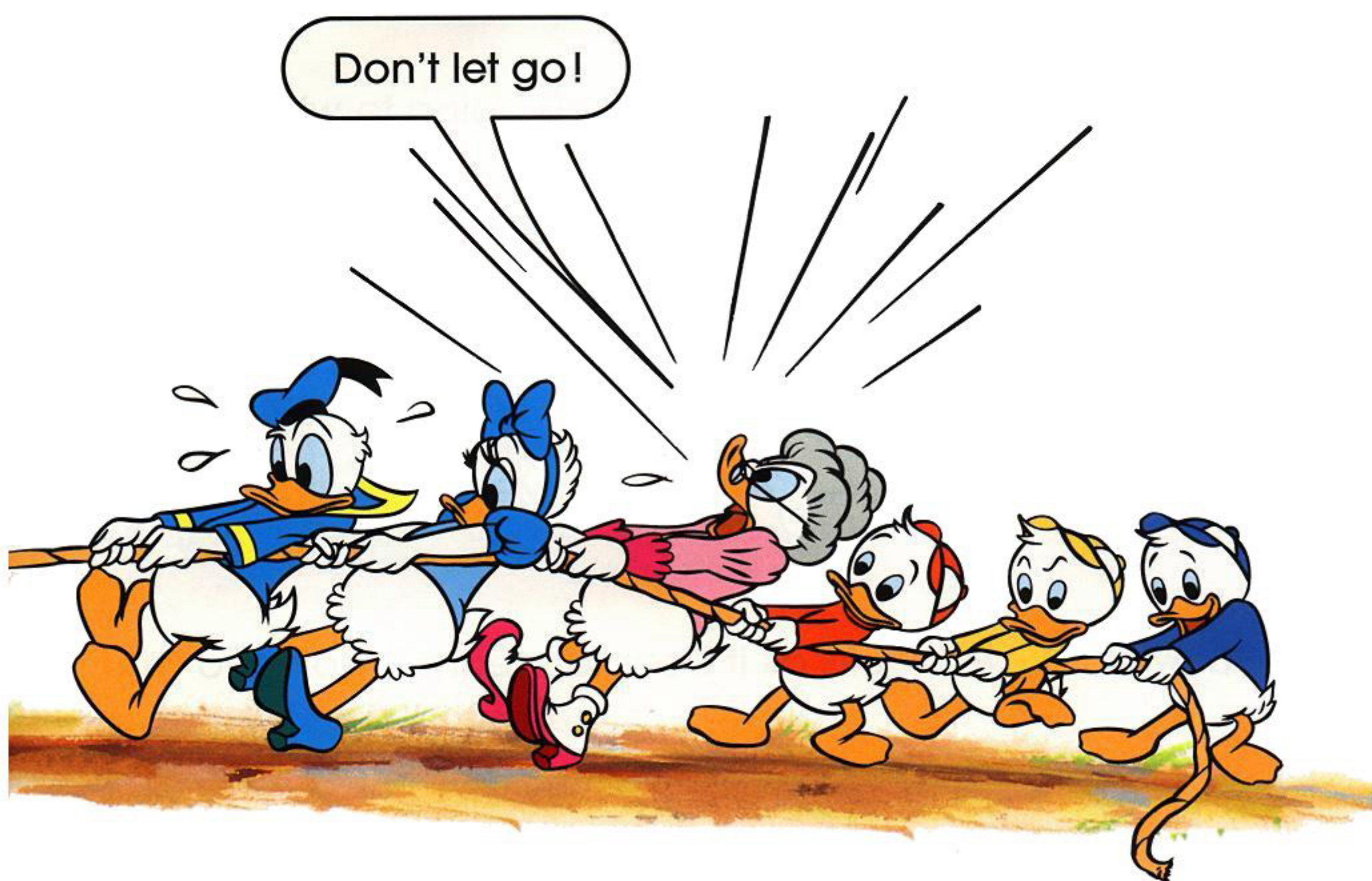




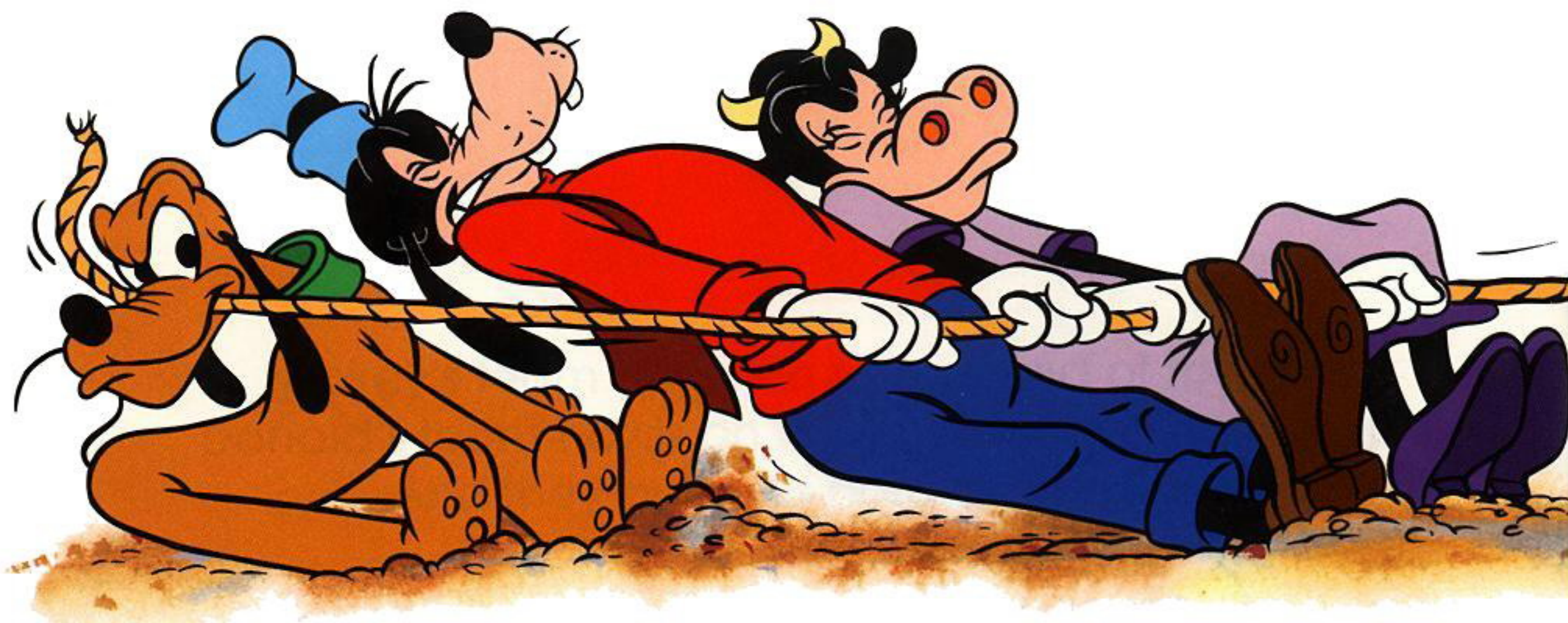
Mickey's team holds on to one end of the rope.

And they pull—as hard as they can!







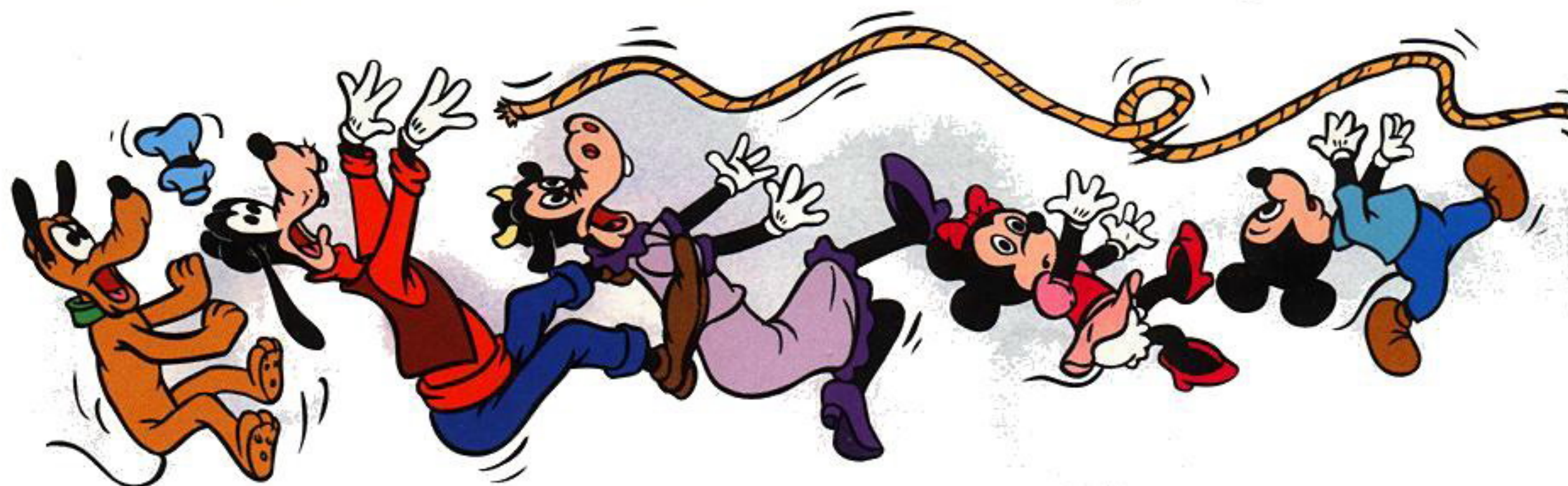




It looks as if Mickey's team is going to win!

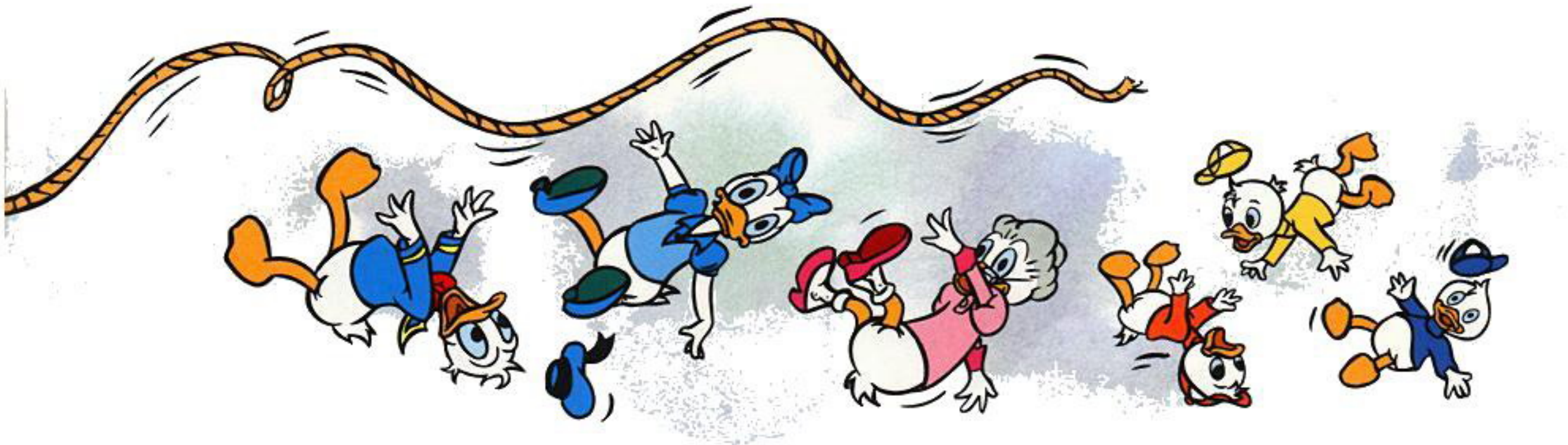
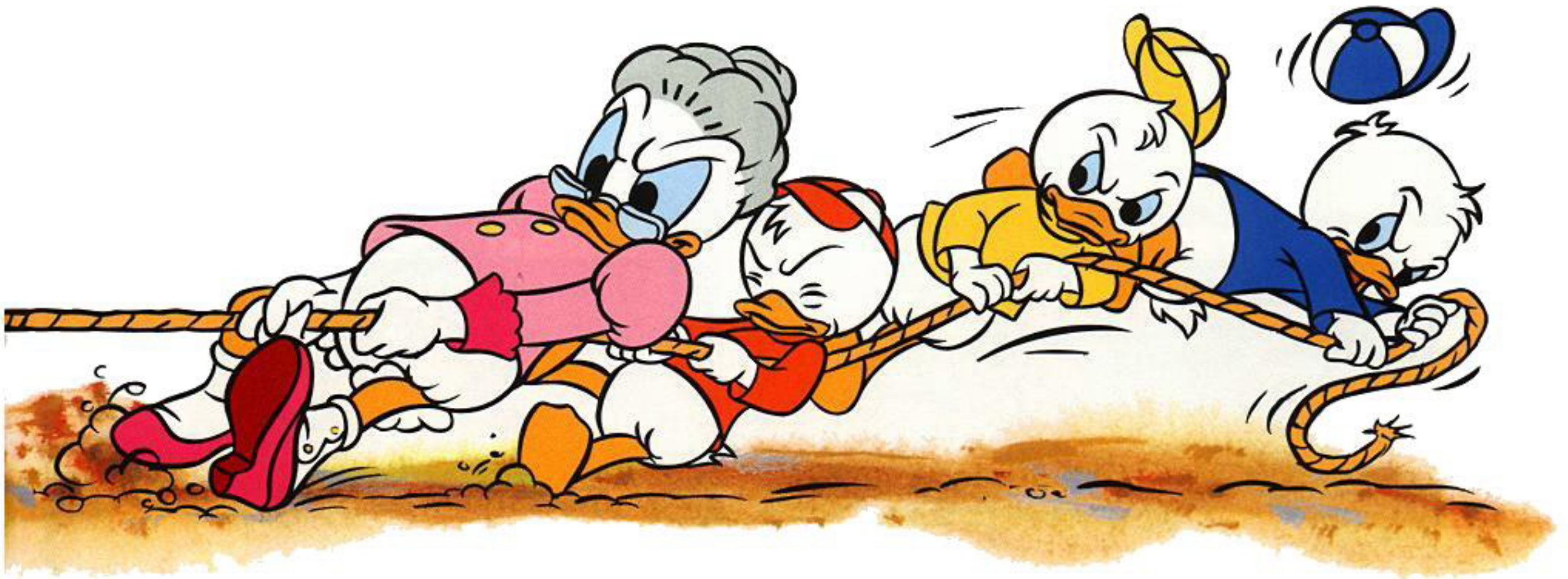
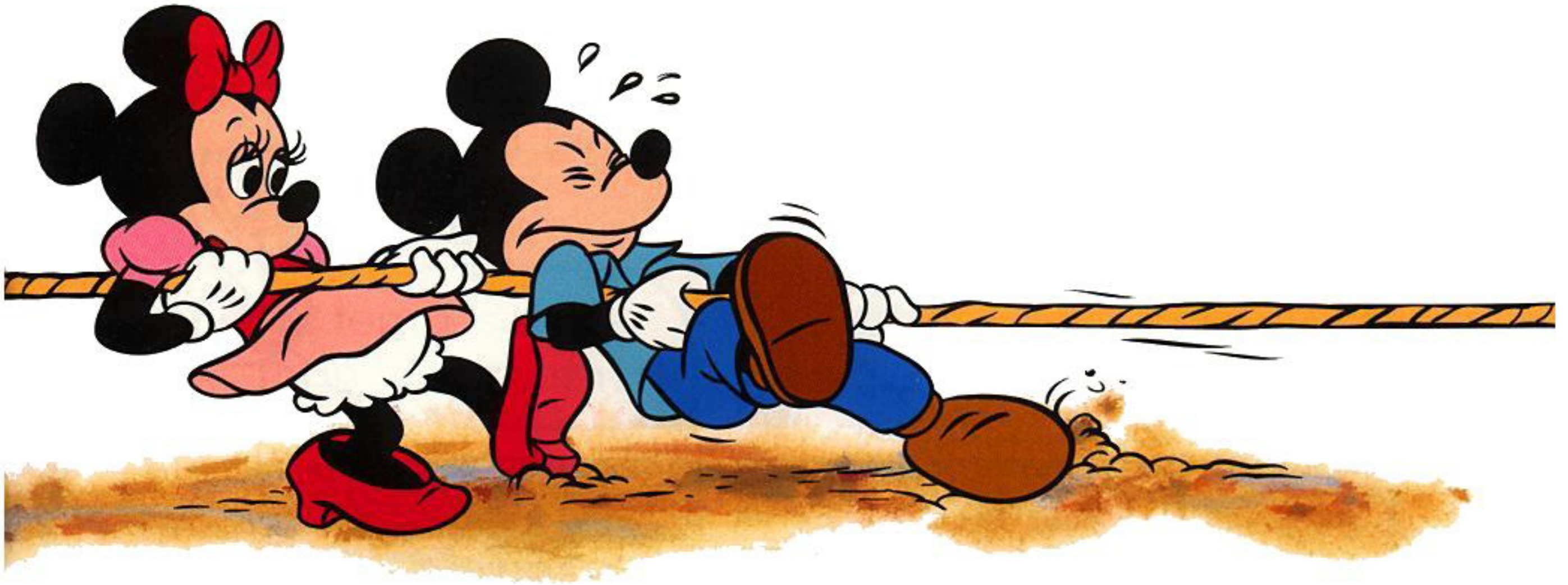

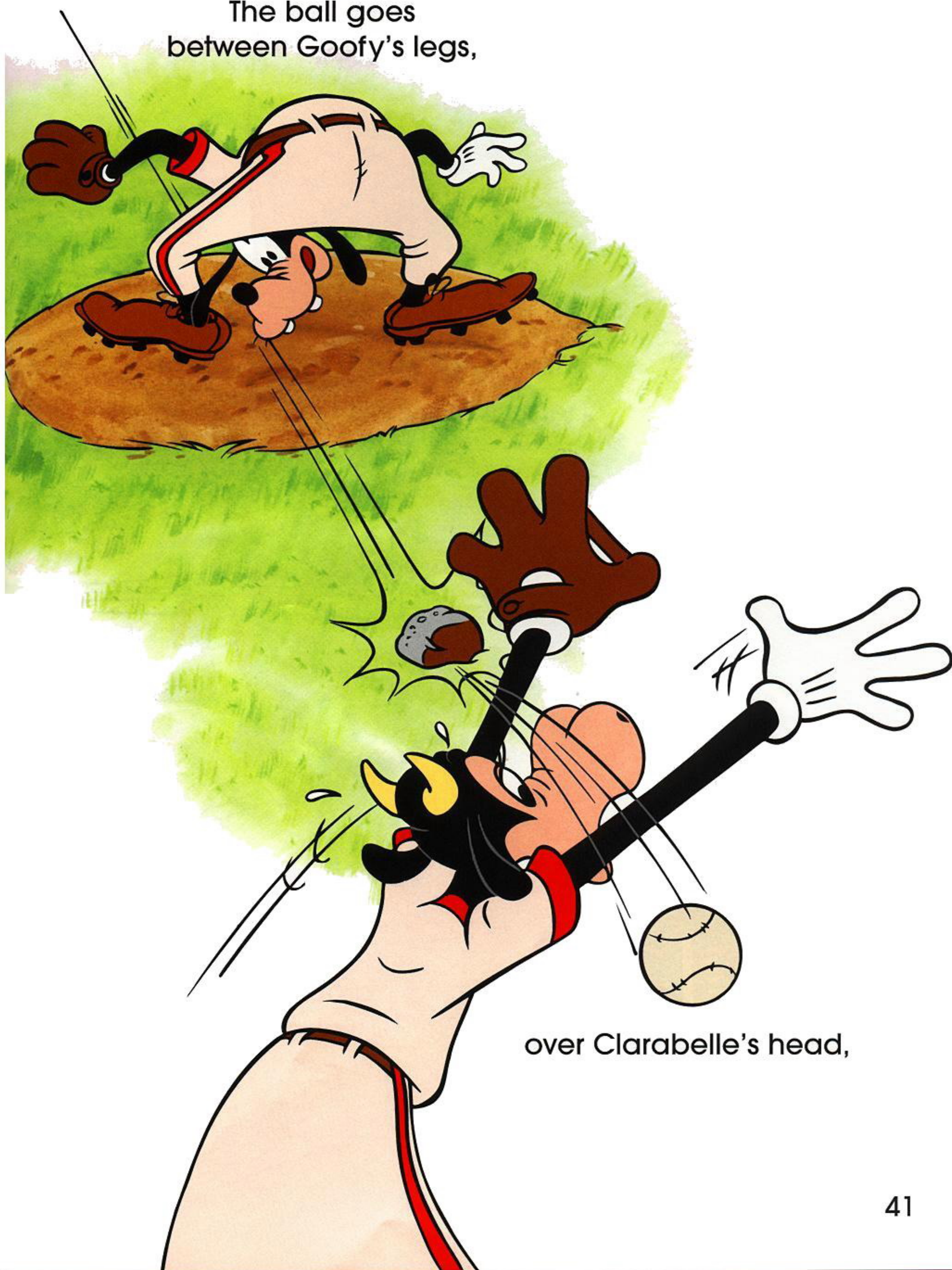


Now Dewey is up to bat.

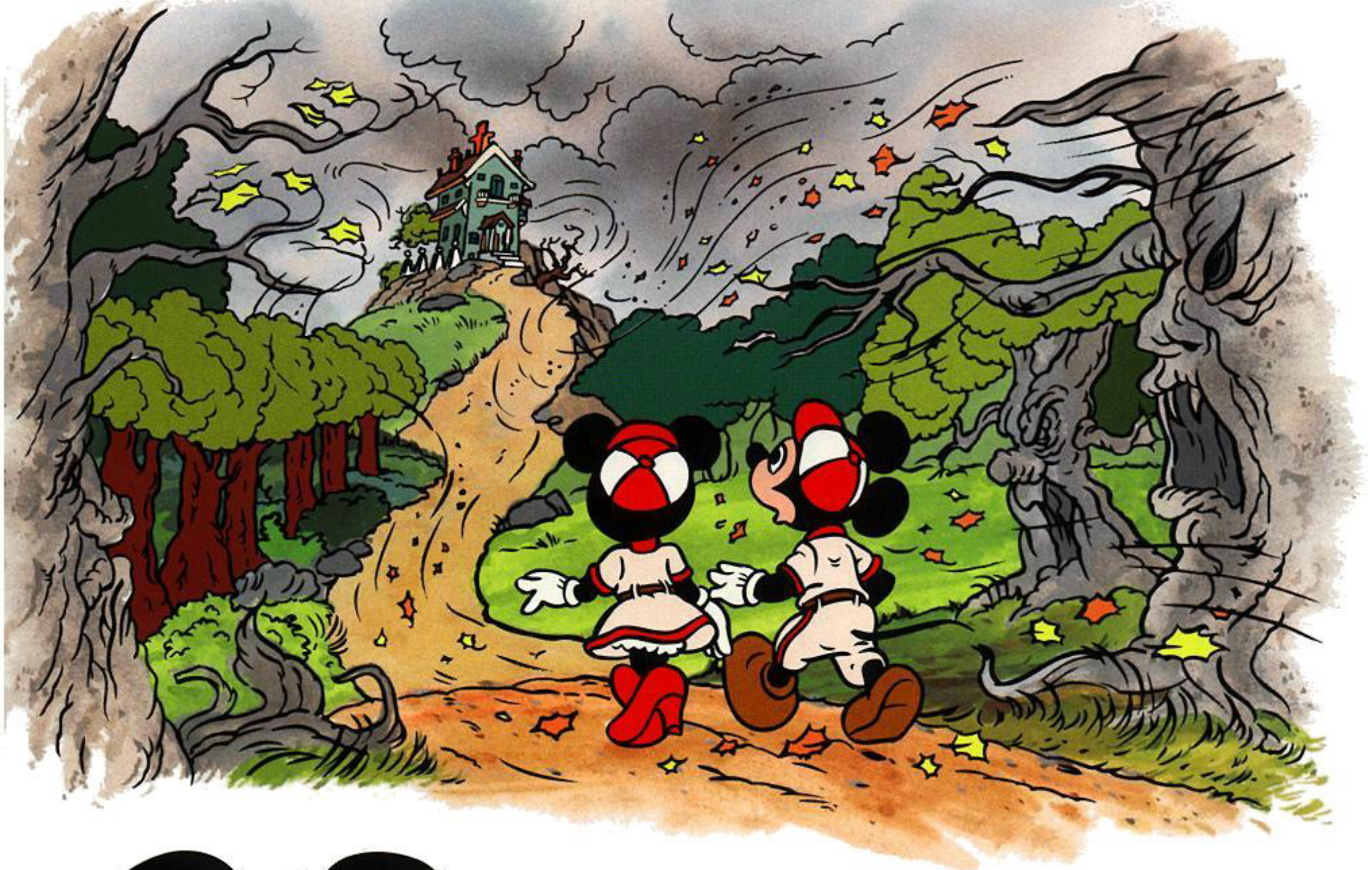
The ball is in that house.

Mickey and Minnie arrive at the house. What is Mickey pointing at?

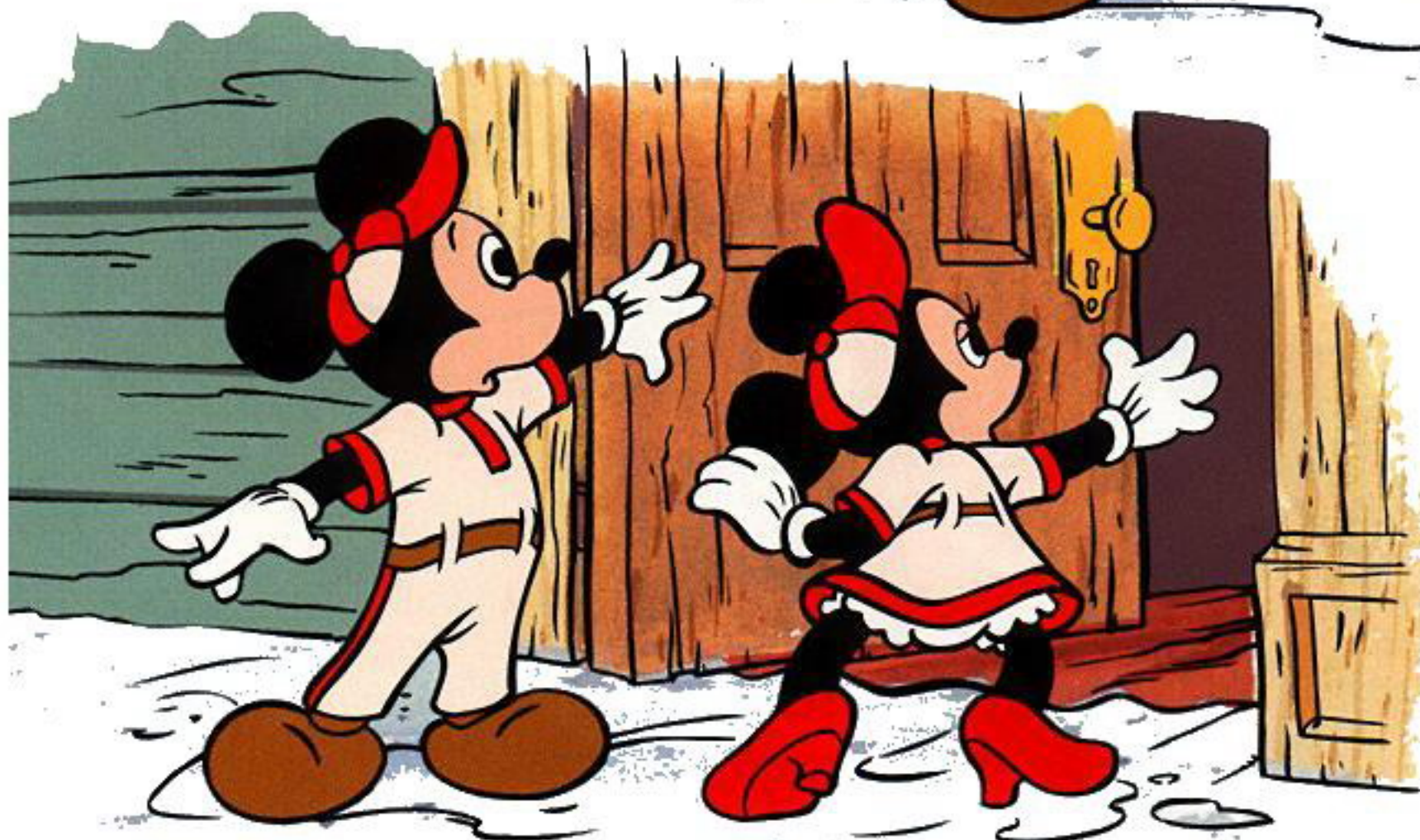


Minnie knocks on the door.

and go inside.





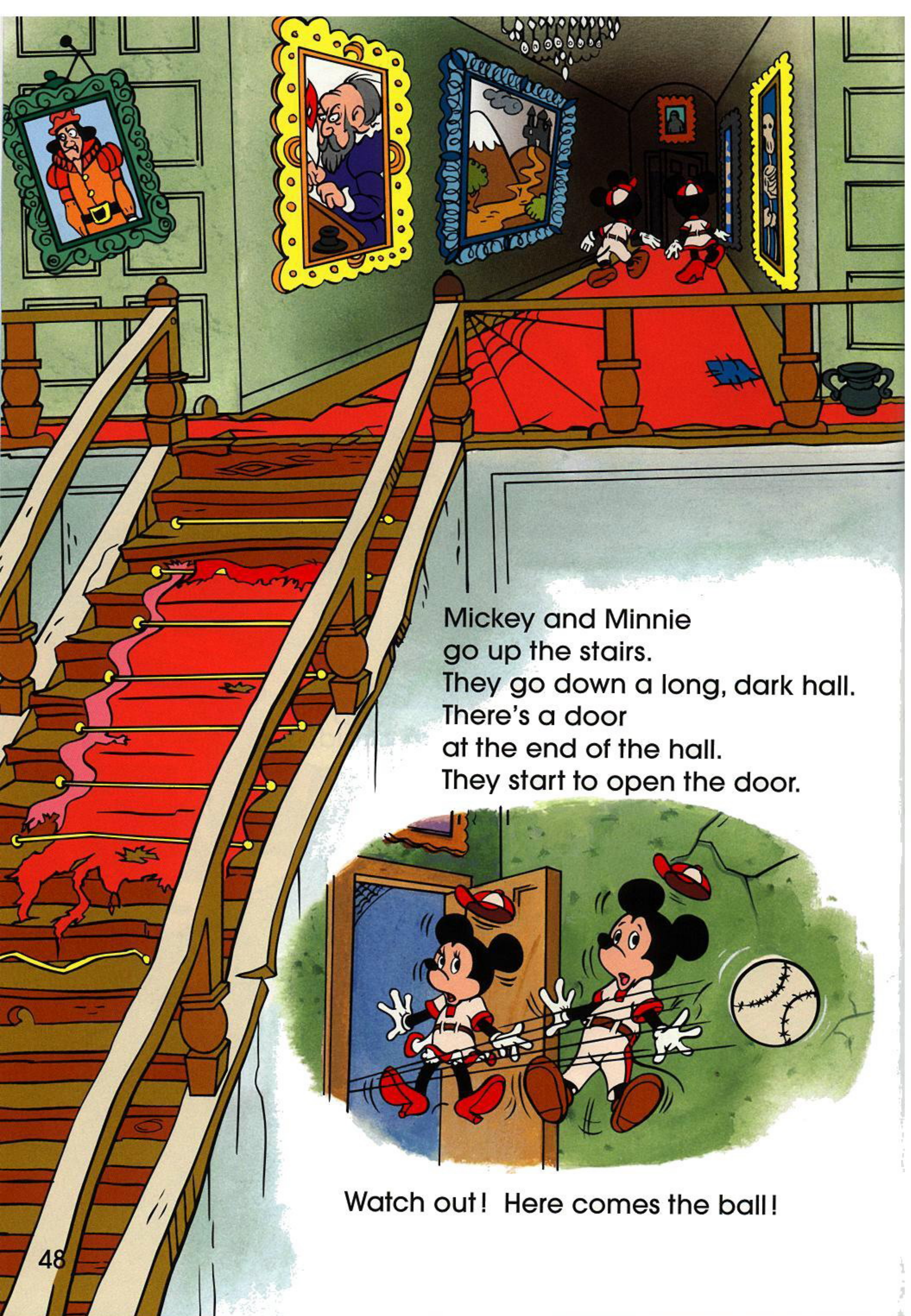


I'm afraid, too.
