







He juggles balls both small and big, And while he juggles, he dances a jig.




He juggles sticks both short and long, And while he juggles, he sings a song.




He juggles eggs and doesn't look, And while he juggles, he reads a book.

He juggles while eating an ice cream cone.




He juggles and juggles and doesn't stop Unless what he's juggling happens to drop.











And now. . .the Fat Lady, the Thin Man, the Tall Man, and the Small Man!




The Fat Lady's very, very fat— From her head down to her toes. The Fat Lady is so fat that She doesn't fit into her clothes.

He can't wear a bracelet. He can't wear a ring. He's much, much too thin for that kind of thing.




He doesn't eat breakfast. He doesn't eat dinner.
