
Every morning, the sun comes up, and a new day begins.













The chickens are all still asleep in their house. The rooster walks up and knocks on the door.





Go away, Rooster! We would like to sleep some more.






But all the chickens are wide awake,

For with so much noise, who could sleep now?






## We know it's time to get up when the alarm clock starts to ring. It's very hard to sleep with so much noise!







Daisy wakes Huey, Dewey, and Louie up.




Daisy goes upstairs and finds Huey, Dewey, and Louie—still in bed!




After they get up, they go to the bathroom and wash up.

While they are getting dressed, Daisy makes them sandwiches for lunch.







Who gets up before everyone else? Who gets up after everyone else?






















Huey, Dewey, and Louie are almost out the door when Daisy sees Louie's lunch box on the table.




Usually Huey, Dewey, and Louie walk to school, but today they have to run because they are very late.




There's the bell! They get there just in time!







Huey, Dewey, and Louie learn a lot of things in school.



## Look at the clock. It's twelve o'clock noon—time to eat lunch.




Everyone puts away his books and paper and pencils and goes to the lunch room.




Huey, Dewey, and Louie eat lunch with all their friends. They eat the sandwiches that they brought from home.
























On Saturday and Sunday, there is no school. Today is Sunday, and Huey, Dewey, and Louie are going to the zoo.




The first person that they meet at the zoo is the zookeeper. He tells them what they shouldn't do when they are at the zoo.















Huey, Dewey, and Louie don't know which way to go first.




The lion is the king of all the animals in the zoo, And that is why he wears a crown, just as all kings do.



So when you're at the lion's cage, bow down very low, And say, "Hello, Your Majesty," to show him that you know That the lion is the king of all the animals in the zoo.






When the tiger is happy, he smiles.







When the tiger is sad, he cries.




When the tiger is sleepy, he yawns,



There is one giraffe at the zoo that is different from all of the others.




After they see the lion, the tiger, and the giraffes, Huey, Dewey, and Louie go to see the hippopotamus. The hippopotamus has very big teeth.






The zebra has stripes all over the place— Stripes of white and black. He has stripes on his legs, on his tail, on his face, And stripes running down his back.




Zebras don't live in houses, but if they did, what would a zebra's house look like?



Five funny monkeys live in the zoo, and what one monkey does, the other four do!






Look! It's a mother kangaroo and her baby!



A baby kangaroo jumps wherever his mother jumps.




A baby kangaroo visits whoever his mother visits.
